As guests of the People's Republic of China, event participation and site access will be determined by our hosts. Access to the Great Hall of the People during the meetings will be extremely limited. In addition, logistical considerations will impact on event participation. The Advance Office will distribute a nightly schedule update and event participation list for the following day's activities.

We are visiting China at the height of its tourist season. Therefore, transportation resources for independent requirements are limited. Please make any requests for independent transportation well in advance so we may make every effort to meet your requests.

Everyone traveling with the President will be issued one trip pin by the Chinese upon arrival in Beijing, which must be worn at all times. If this pin is lost, you will be denied any future access to events. In addition, you are required to wear your White House Staff pin or traveling guest pin at all times.

Part One of the schedule details the President's activities through April 28 in Beijing. Additionally, a summary schedule of the entire trip is included for your informational purposes. Part Two of the detailed schedule - Xi'an, Shanghai and arrival in Alaska - will be distributed in Beijing on April 28. Part Three, the detailed schedule for Alaska, will be distributed upon arrival in Alaska.

Souvenir schedules of the President's Trip to the People's Republic of China will be distributed after our return.

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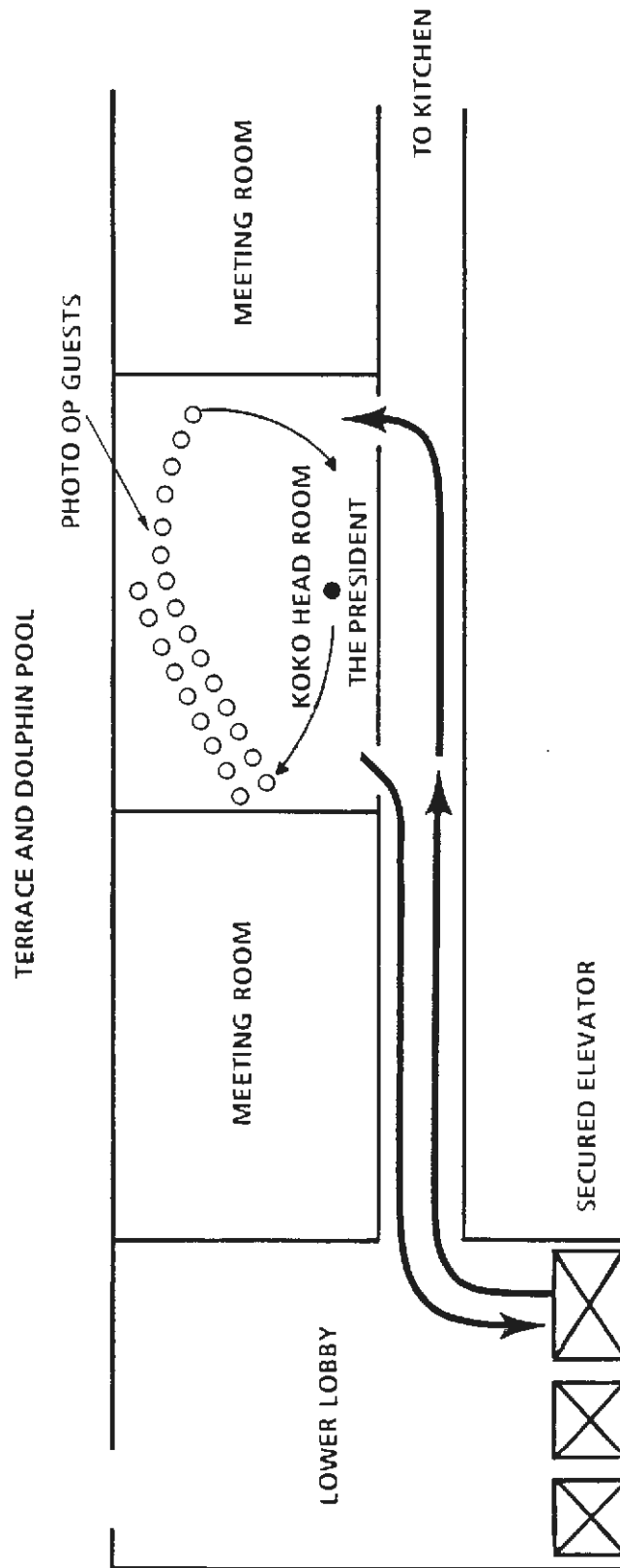
