THIS HAS BEEN A VERY EXCITING DAY FOR ME PARTICULARLY BECAUSE THIS IS, AS THE MINISTER SAID, THE FIRST TIME THAT I HAVE BEEN IN CHINA, A DAY I HAVE LOOKED FORWARD TO FOR A VERY LONG TIME, SINCE LONG BEFORE ! ENTERED OUR GOVERNMENT, AND IT IS A DAY WHICH CERTAINLY IS FULFILLING ALL THE HOPES AND EXPECTATIONS THAT I HAD. I PARTICULARLY APPRECIATED THE VERY FINE CEREMONY

WITH THE SPLENDID TROOPS AT THE MILITARY MUSEUM AND THE OPPORTUNITY TO SEE AT LAST THE FORBIDDEN CITY AND THE PALACE MUSEUM, BOTH OF WHICH WERE EXTRAORDINARILY INTERESTING AND FINE OPPORTUNITIES FOR US TO SEE BOTH THE SKILLS OF MODERN CHINA AND THE WISDOM AND ANTIQUITIES OF ANCIENT CHINA.

THE MANY AMERICANS WHO HAVE VISITED CHINA, PARTICULARLY THOSE WITH WHOM I HAVE WORKED PRESIDENT NIXON, PRESIDENT FORD AND HENRY KISSINGER AND MANY OTHERS, HAVE ALL TOLD ME OF THE WARMTH AND HOSPITALITY OF THIS NATION AND OF THE GREAT FRIENDSHIP IT HAS FOR THE UNITED STATES AND THE UNITED STATES HAS FOR CHINA AND CERTAINLY ALL THEIR STATEMENTS HAVE BEEN FULFILLED.

THE UNITED STATES AND CHINA SHARE MANY IMPORTANT STRATEGIC CONCERNS. PART OF OUR RELATIONSHIP IS AN ONGOING DIALOGUE ABOUT THOSE CONCERNS AND ABOUT OUR RESPECTIVE INTERESTS AND THIS VISIT PROVIDES A REAL OPPORTUNITY, A FINE OPPORTUNITY FOR US TO CONTINUE THE DEFENSE PART OF THAT ONGOING DIALOGUE. SO WE LOOK FORWARD VERY MUCH TO AN EXCHANGE OF VIEWS ABOUT ALL OF THESE GLOBAL AND REGIONAL ISSUES, AS WELL AS THE BILATERAL MATTERS IN THE SPIRIT OF MUTUAL FRIENDSHIP AND CONFIDENCE. IN THIS CONNECTION WE WELCOME THE VISIT OF FOREIGN MINISTER WU TO THE UNITED STATES NEXT MONTH. WE ANTICIPATE OTHER HIGH LEVEL VISITS BY BOTH SIDES TO CONTINUE OUR DIALOGUE ON THE STRATEGIC ISSUES AND TO DEVELOP FURTHER OUR BILATERAL RELATIONSHIPS. THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE BELIEVE THAT VERY CLOSE UNITED STATES AND CHINA RELATIONS AND COOPERATION IN THE STRATEGIC AREA WILL SERVE BOTH OF OUR NATIONAL INTERESTS AND ALSO THE INTERESTS OF WORLD PEACE AND STABILITY.
