#### UNOFFICIAL TRANSLATION

Mr. Ronald Reagan President of the United State of America

Dear Mr. President;

Greetings with my best wishes that all is well with you. I received your letter in which you have mentioned about the decision of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia with regard to the Nuclear Non-Proliferation treaty and its clear signal to all concerned parties. Also, of your excellency's concern with regard to the missile proliferation and the spread of the non-convential military capabilities in the region and your country's strong urges to the Israelis for exercising self restrains.

I would like to thank you and your great country for the kind and gracious expressions of friendship. As far as the nuclear non-proliferation treaty is concerned, I would like to assure you that the Kingdom f Saudi Arabia had and would always be committed to regional and international security and stability. Further more, the Kingdom is willing to participate in any positive efforts to ensure the ahcievement of such cause. Since the Kingdom believe that the human being in his present and future is not only looking forward strongly for the establishment of security and peace but also for purging off the danger of any war in the future. The step, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia took with regard to the nuclear non-proliferation treaty is indeed a part of its sincere and genuine wish for securing the security and peace on the basis of justice not only in the Middle East but also in all regions of the world.

I, sincerely, hope Mr. President, that in adhering to the treaty, cooperation in the field of nuclear energy for peaceful uses by countries that do not possess nuclear arsenal and are part of such treaty would flourish. In light of that I appreciate very much your welcoming cooperation between our two friendly countries in the nuclear fields. In our commitment to this cause I am very much convinced that cooperation between our two countries would bring forth many positive results.



As to what you have mentioned Mr. President that you have notified the Congress officially of the contract to enhance the operation and maintenance of AWACS and to supply us 200 fighting vehicles (BRADLY) I would like to express to you my sincere appreciation for this positive gesture which is an other example of our good historical relation. I, sincerely, hope that all of our efforts to enhance positive cooperation between our two countries will succeed.

Please accept Mr. President my utmost regards and wishes of your health and happiness and prosperity to the American people. God bless you.
