GEORGE QUINCEY LUMSDEN, JR.AMBASSADOR TO THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

George Quincey Lumsden, Jr., was sworn in as United States Ambassador to the United Arab Emirates on July 12, 1982. Previous to this assignment, he had served since 1979 at the State Department as Deputy Director for Arabian Peninsula Affairs.

Mr. Lumsden was born in Montclair, New Jersey, on September 19, 1930. He graduated from Princeton University in 1952 and did graduate work at the Georgetown University School of Foreign Service.

He joined the State Department in 1957, following four years service overseas in the United States Navy. He was posted as Vice Consul at Izmir, Turkey in 1959, and has subsequently held the following diplomatic and consular positions: Economic Officer, Bonn (1962-64); Consul, Amman (1965-67); Attache, Beirut (1967-69); Chief of Economic Section, Kuwait (1969-72); and General Economic Policy Officer, Paris (1976-79). In Washington, he has served as Country Officer for Kuwait, Bahrain, Qatar, and the United Arab Emirates (1972-75).

Mr. Lumsden speaks Arabic, French, and German. He is married to the former Helene Parissis and has two children, William Alexander (DOB-1962) and Catherine Parissis (DOB-1964).
