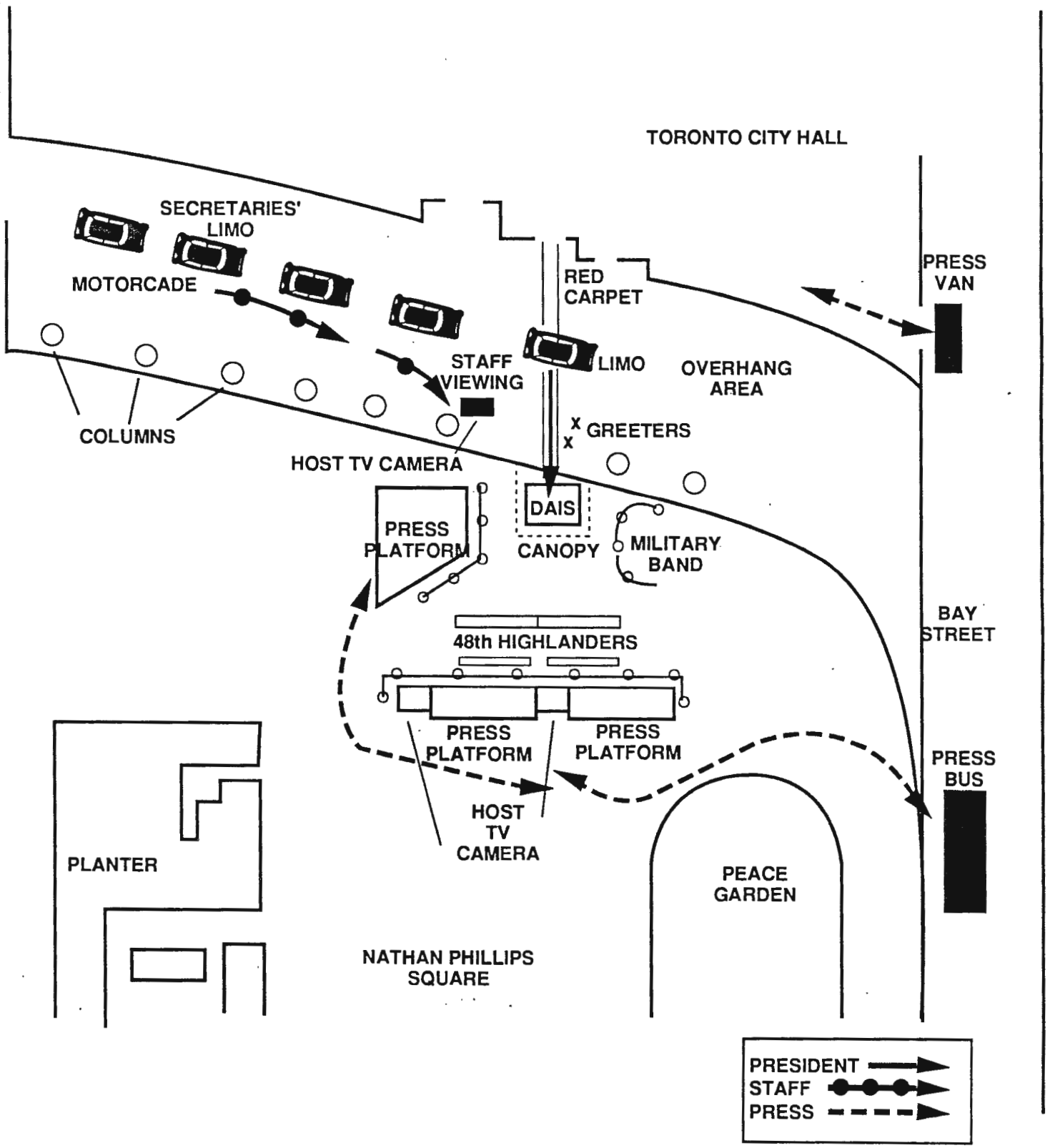
**BILATERAL #1 SEATING DIAGRAM

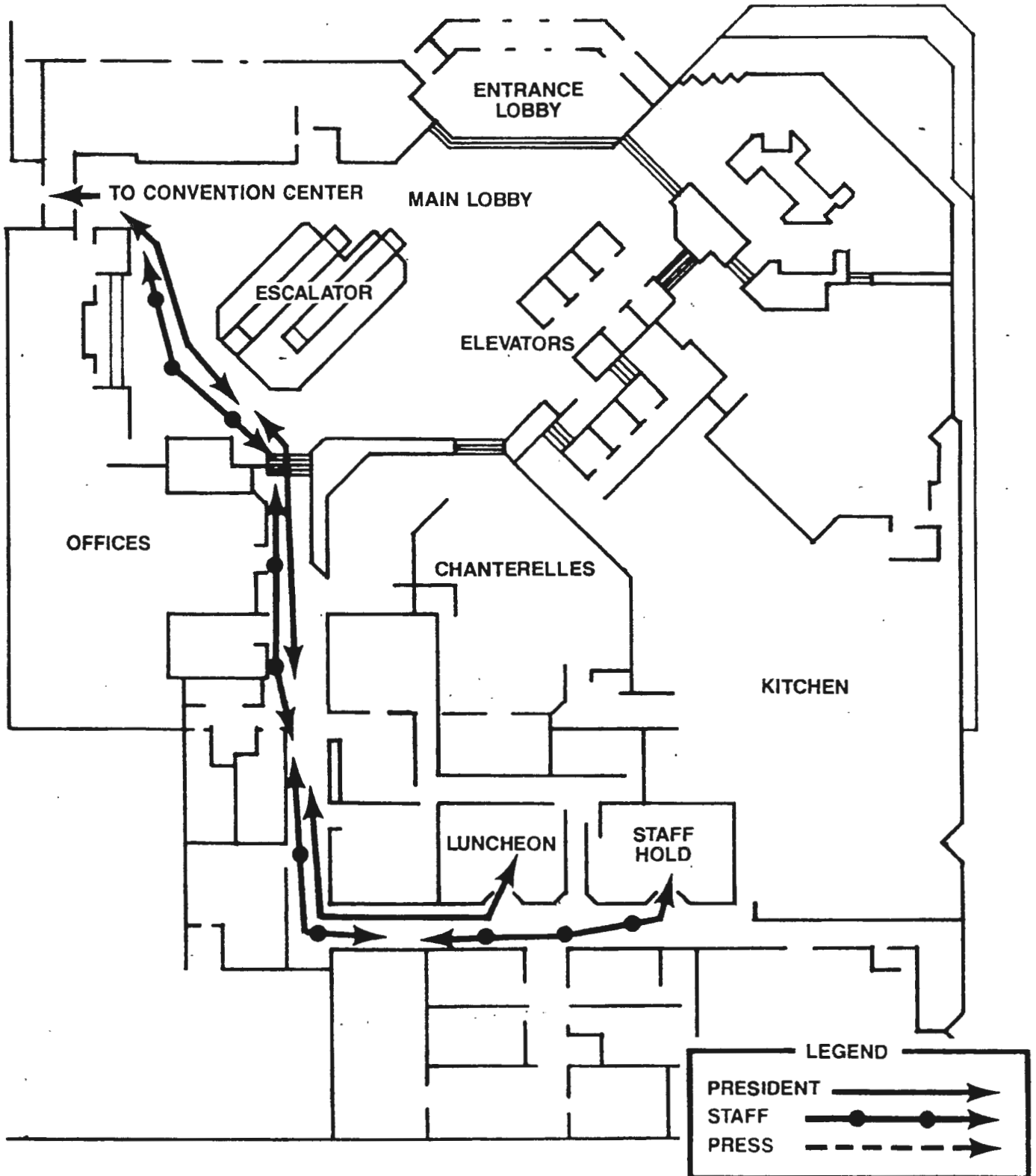
# DINNER SEATING DIAGRAM THE TORONTO HUNT CLUB

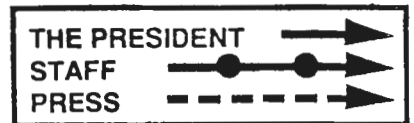


# ROY THOMSON HALL GROUND LEVEL JOINT COMMUNIQUE
