# EC Influence on World Sugar Markets

Sugar is exported by the EC on a political rather than an economic basis, and exports are heavily subsidized. When world prices are low the EC exports sugar rather than buy it at guaranteed support prices because it is less costly to pay export subsidies. The subsidies are theoretically equal to the difference between the EC support (intervention) price and world price. In reality, however, the subsidy must be large enough to clear the market and will often exceed the difference.

During the marketing year, the EC's Sugar Management Committee estimates the total amount of sugar available for export and sets a weekly target quantity to be awarded an export subsidy. At each weekly session, producers submit to the Management Committee a unit rate bid of the subsidy considered necessary to sell sugar on the world market. Subsidies are awarded to the least expensive bids first until the authorized quantity is reached. EC export subsidies for authorized sales of sugar have increased from 2.1 cents per pound in April, 1981, to a high of 14.3 cents in May, 1982. Obviously, in a surplus supply situation, EC sugar can continue to underbid other sugar suppliers and drive world prices down.


In 1980, a GATT panel investigating complaints filed by Australia and Brazil found that EC export subsidies granted during the years 1975/76, 1976/77 and 1977/78 resulted in lower EC white sugar prices than world prices. The panel also found that EC white sugar had been quoted at prices lower than those for raw sugar.

Prior to 1975, the EC was a net importer of sugar. But since that time EC exports have increased to the point that the EC is now the second largest exporter of free world sugar. During the period 1976-1981, the EC consistently expanded sugar imports where its share of the free world market grew from 7.7 percent to over 20 percent. Due to subsidized EC sugar exports, world raw sugar prices, which amounted to 41 cents per pound in October 1980, declined to 11.66 cents per pound in September 1981, and under nine cents per pound in May 1982.


Since the domestic U.S. prices are directly linked to world market prices, the EC sugar policy had a harmful effect on the domestic sugar market. By depressing world prices, the EC export policy also depressed U.S. prices to a point below the support price set in the Agriculture and Food Act of 1981.

With the continued decline in world prices caused by the high volume of EC subsidized sugar being exported into the world market, the U.S. could no longer support the domestic price for sugar producers with the fee and duty system provided in the sugar program. When upper limit for the fee authority was reached and the world price continued to decline, the U.S. was forced to impose sugar quotas to maintain the domestic market price at levels required to insure no takeover of sugar by the Commodity Credit Corporation.

#### EC AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS TO THE U.S.S.R.

The European Community increased its agricultural exports to the Soviet Union dramatically in the last two years. In terms of European Currency Units (ECU's), EC shipments to the Soviet Union increased by about three times between 1979 and 1980 (213 percent). The trade value of the 12 major commodities examined, which account for the bulk of total EC agricultural exports to the Soviet Union, increased from 277.6 million ECU's in 1979 to 869.8 million ECU's in 1980. In dollars, the increase was from \$371 million to \$1,211 million.

For the first nine months of 1981 (more up-to-date EC data is not yet available) the EC has already exported more to the Soviet Union than in all of 1980 -- 958.3 million ECU's or about \$1,073 million. If the 1981 nine month trade total is extrapolated over the full 12 months, EC shipments to the Soviet Union can be estimated at 1,277 million ECU's or \$1,430 million, an increase of 47 percent over 1980 in terms of ECU's.

The attached tables show a more complete breakdown of EC exports to the Soviet Union in quantities and values (ECU's). Significant increases in shipments have occurred in nearly all commodities. The following are some highlights of the most important aspects of the Community's expanding agricultural trade with the Soviet Union (data comparisons are in volume terms):

- -- All commodities with the exception of soybean meal and oil are eligible for EC export subsidies.
- -- Beef exports increased 297 percent in 1980 over 1979; estimated 1981 exports will fall back to 46 percent of the 1980 level but will still be 83 percent higher than in 1979; the EC did not export beef to the Soviet Union in 1978.
- -- EC wheat exports increased from zero in 1978 to 5 thousand tons in 1979, to 576 thousand tons in 1980 before falling back to an estimated 45 thousand tons in 1981.
- -- EC wheat flour exports were zero in both 1978 and 1979 but were 330 thousand tons in 1980 and are estimated at 709 thousand in 1981, an increase of 115 percent over 1980.
- -- Mixed feed exports to the Soviet Union were zero in both 1978 and 1979 but were 70.8 thousand tons in 1980; in 1981, mixed feed exports are estimated to have increased by 9 times over 1980, to 637 thousand tons.
- -- Soybean meal exports jumped by 1,415 percent from 1979 to 1980 and is estimated to have more than doubled in 1981 over 1980; the EC did not export soybean meal to the Soviet Union in 1978.
- -- EC sugar shipments increased by almost three times from 1979 to 1980 (188 percent) and are estimated to be up another 6 percent in 1981; the EC did not export sugar to the Soviet Union in 1978.
