The NSC Staff concurs that the World Tourism Organization meets criteria for eligibility as established in the Bulletin of the Department of State, Vol. XIV, at 348-49 (March 3, 1946). The qualifications and potential benefits for the U.S. merit our approval. We therefore concur with the Department of State's recommendation that the proposed Executive Order be submitted to the President for designation of the World Tourism Organization as an international organization.

Dear Mr. Stockman:

In accordance with Executive Order 11030, as amended, enclosed is a proposed Executive order and seven copies. The Order would designate the World Tourism Organization (WTO), as a public international organization for purposes of the International Organizations Immunities Act of 1945, P.L. 79-291, as amended (22 U.S.C. 288 et seq.).

The Act accords privileges, exemptions and immunities to eligible public international organizations designated by Executive order and, inter alia, to the officers and employees of such organizations. Under Executive Order 9698 of February 19, 1946 (11 F.R. 1809), the Secretary of State has been delegated the exclusive authority to receive applications and submit recommendations to the President concerning designation of organizations under the Act.

The substantive criteria for eligibility under the Act are set out in the statute and elaborated in the Bulletin of the Department of State, Vol. XIV, at 348-49 (March 3, 1946). First, the organization must do sufficient business within the United States to warrant granting it the privileges of the Act. Second, the Government of the United States must participate in the organization. Third, that participation must be pursuant to a treaty or under the authority of an act of Congress authorizing such participation or making an appropriation for such participation. Fourth, the organization must be composed principally of governments, and finally, it must not be scheduled for liquidation.

The World Tourism Organization meets these criteria. It is an international organization of an inter-governmental character which replaced the International Union of Official Travel Organizations, a non-governmental organization. United States participation in the WTO is pursuant to a treaty, the Statutes of the World Tourism Organisation, 27 UST 2211, TIAS 8307, which entered into force with respect

to the United States on December 16, 1975 and has over a hundred states parties. The Organization also has affiliate members who may be inter-governmental or non-governmental international bodies but do not enjoy the voting rights of full membership which is open only to states. Among its affiliate members are Pan American Airlines, American Express Publishing Corporation and the Travel Industry Association of America. Greater participation of U.S. affiliate members in WTO should stimulate travel to the United States and the United States plans to take an active role in increasing the effectiveness of the Organization. To this end, we have extended, and the Organization has accepted, an invitation to hold the 25th session of the WTO Executive Council in Washington in May 1985. That session will be chaired by the Under Secretary of Commerce and will, among other things, nominate the next WTO Secretary General. We hope to encourage the Organization to hold other official functions in the United States in the future as well. WTO is also closely linked with the United Nations. Although not a specialized agency of the United Nations, it reports to the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations and has other relationship agreements with the UN Development Program (UNDP), the ILO, WHO and UNEP. In view of WTO's significant and close contacts with the UN and U.S. commercial activities, as well as the potential benefits to the U.S. tourism industry, we believe the nature of involvement of the Organization in the United States fully warrants its designation under the Act.

Accordingly, the Department of State recommends that the President execute the enclosed Executive order, designating the World Tourism Organization as an international organization for the purposes of the Act. The Department of Commerce strongly supports this recommendation. In view of the upcoming meeting of the WTO Executive Council, we hope that the necessary interagency co-ordination can be completed and the proposed Executive order submitted to the President at an early date.

SUMMARY. This memorandum forwards for your consideration a proposed Executive order which would designate the World Tourism Organization as a public international organization for purposes of the International Organizations Immunities Act of 1945, Public Law 79-291, as amended (22 U.S.C. 288 et seq).

BACKGROUND. The Act accords certain privileges, exemptions and immunities to eligible public international organizations that are designated by Executive order. As reflected in the attached memorandum from the Department of State, the World Tourism Organization meets these substantive criteria.

Designation of the World Tourism Organization under the Act has been requested by the Secretary of State to facilitate a planned meeting of the Organization in this country in May 1985. Greater participation of the United States affiliate members of World Tourism Organization should stimulate travel to the United States and would allow the United States to take an active role in increasing the effectiveness of the Organization.

None of the affected agencies objects to the proposed Executive order.

RECOMMENDATION. I recommend that you sign the proposed Executive order.
