SUBJECT: NSC Meeting on MBFR -- September 6, 1983

At yesterday's meeting of the Interdepartmental Group on Mutual and Balanced Force Reductions (MBFR), a new draft of an options paper headed for NSC consideration was reviewed and changes were adopted, and it was agreed by all that we were essentially ready for an NSC meeting on MBFR at the beginning of September.

As you know, the bilateral initiative involving data exchange and verification trade-offs, which Ambassador Mort Ambramowitz was authorized to launch with the Soviets in June, was generally rejected by them, although the Soviets gave us some hints about possible movement on the verification front. At issue now is whether the bilateral initiative ought to be made part of a public negotiating position on the part of the NATO Alliance as a whole, and/or whether it should be significantly altered or dropped altogether.

The private bilateral US initiative with the USSR was the subject of private consultations by Ambassador Abramowitz with the United Kingdom and the Federal Republic of Germany. Any new initiative, particularly one involving public Alliance positions, would need to be the subject of similar consultations, beginning with the British and the Germans. The calendar imposing a requirement for an early NSC meeting on MBFR options (on which there are very substantial interagency disagreements) is as follows:

- September 13: Trilateral US/FRG/UK meeting prior to which time US would have had to transmit any changes of position to seek their preliminary reaction.
- September 19: Possible US proposal tabled in NATO.
- September 29: Fall MBFR round opens in Vienna.
- October 6: West formally tables new proposal, if adopted, in Vienna.
