State forwarded you a memorandum (Tab A) recommending that the President meet with Chancellor Kohl sometime during the last week of October. This meeting would not constitute an official visit, but rather would be a working visit. Such a meeting would provide an important opportunity for the President to meet and exchange ideas with the new head of the German government. However, given the November elections, the end of October will be a very busy time for the President. Ergo, at Tab I is a schedule proposal recommending that the President meet with Chancellor Kohl sometime between mid-November and mid-December. (C)

Subject: Proposed Visit to Washington by FRG Chancellor

Helmut Kohl

During a bilateral meeting at the United Nations in New York this morning, FRG Foreign Minister Hans-Dietrich Genscher told Secretary Shultz that Chancellor Helmut Kohl would like to visit Washington as soon as possible to meet with the President. At the beginning of his tenure as Chancellor, Kohl would like to discuss with the President a range of major issues with which our two governments will be dealing in the months ahead.

In view of the importance of the U.S.-FRG relationship and of the many issues before us, the Department strongly recommends that the President meet with Chancellor Kohl within the next few weeks. We would recommend that Kohl pay a working visit to Washington, not an official visit. We would foresee a one-hour meeting with the President followed by a working luncheon hosted by the President. Genscher proposed early November as a possible time for the Kohl visit to Washington. However, since we understand that the President's calendar for this period is rather heavy, we would recommend that the President agree to receive Helmut Kohl at some point during the last week of October.
