Possible Meeting with the President

After a considerable effort, DoD has tracked down German Defense Minister Woerner's U.S. vacation schedule. He leaves tomorrow on a raft trip down the Colorado River, and in effect will be out of touch until next Friday evening, August 26. Unfortunately, his raft trip corresponds with the period in which we hoped to have him meet with the President in Los Angeles. He apparently will be reachable from August 27 to 30 in Colorado Springs, but this does not meet the time parameters you set. Woerner will be in Washington briefly on August 31, but the President will not, as you know.

RECOMMENDATION

That you inform the Judge of our support of Secretary Weinberger's recommendation, (Tab A) but that the President's and Woerner's vacation schedules preclude a meeting in August. I further recommend that you suggest to the Judge that he inform Secretary Weinberger of our efforts the next time they talk. The Judge should also indicate to Secretary Weinberger our willingness to try to get Woerner in to see the President, schedule permitting, the next time he is in Washington.

Celebration in Philadelphia

Charlie Wick has written you to urge that we reconsider the President's attendance at the Philadelphia Tricentennial celebration on October 6 (Tab A).

For the following reason, I believe that we should stick with our decision for the President not to go:

-- The President will already be meeting with and hosting a state dinner for President Carstens on October 4.

-- Through the President's good offices we have arranged for Carstens to address a joint session of Congress on October 5. Thus there is no foundation to the implied charge that we are not taking the Carstens visit or the Tricentennial seriously.

-- Moreover, both you and the President have written to Kohl and Teltschik in reply to their respective correspondence, explaining that the President's schedule would not permit a trip to Philadelphia. The President emphasized to Kohl that the Vice President would attend as his personal representative. For the President to go now would undercut the VP's role.

-- In light of all the demands we have recently put on the President's aschedule with UN related visits, we should not, in my view, try to block out what would be at least another half day of the President's calendar.

-- Neither the German Government or the State Department have made a reclama within the last three weeks. Thus we are under no foreign policy pressure to change the President's schedule.

-- It is clear from Wick's letter that all the pressure is coming from the Tricentennial Commission. In my view, both the President and other senior officials, like yourself, have already given amply of your valuable time to this worthwhile cause.

RECOMMENDATION

That you call Charlie Wick, and drawing from the above, explain why the President can not go to Philadelphia.
