I need some guidance before submitting a scheduling request for Schmidt.

Schmidt only has a small window of time when the President is possibly available, i.e., Monday morning, April 2. I am not sure that we want to tackle the schedulers on such short notice and with such a tight time-frame, given the following background.

I understand that when Schmidt came to Washington last Spring that we were disinclined to meet with him, or more bluntly, either the President or the Judge said no. EUR is not sure if the Secretary is strongly pushing the meeting, or if he asked for it only because he promised Schmidt he would. You will recall that Shultz is very friendly with Schmidt. EUR, like I, is struck that the Secretary opted to send the request over via the Hill channel, rather than under his own signature (Tab A).

I put the request in the "nice to do", but "not essential" category. In my view, much depends on how many chips we want to spend with the schedulers. Please check with Bud and let me know if I should prepare a scheduling request.

I need some guidance before submitting a scheduling request for Schmidt.

Schmidt only has a small window of time when the President is possibly available, i.e., Monday morning, April 2. I am not sure that we want to tackle the schedulers on such short notice and with such a tight time-frame, given the following background.

I understand that when Schmidt came to Washington last Spring that we were disinclined to meet with him, or more bluntly, either the President or the Judge said no. EUR is not sure if the Secretary is strongly pushing the meeting, or if he asked for it only because he promised Schmidt he would. You will recall that Shultz is very friendly with Schmidt. EUR, like I, is struck that the Secretary opted to send the request over via the Hill channel, rather than under his own signature (Tab A).

I put the request in the "nice to do", but "not essential" category. In my view, much depends on how many chips we want to spend with the schedulers. Please check with Bud and let me know if I should prepare a scheduling request.

#### TALKING POINTS FOR MEETING WITH HELMUT SCHMIDT

- -- We highly value your role and your advice as senior European statesman. I am aware that you are in regular contact with Arthur Burns, who passes on your views.
- It is especially important in the coming years that we reach a better understanding of respective U.S. and European roles. Differences between free nations are to be expected, but we must not forget our shared interests which bind us together.
- -- Misperceptions are often the cause of differences. This will be a special problem in an election year. Europe should not be thrown off course by the election debates. Let me assure you that our policies will remain constant.
- -- We are actively pursuing dialogue with the Soviets aimed at solving real problems, first of all, nuclear arms reductions. I am prepared to meet Chernenko whenever such a meeting could yield tangible results. But if we are to arrange a successful meeting, we must avoid being too optimistic in public. This mistakenly would lead the Soviets to believe I need a meeting for political reasons.

- -- We would seriously consider any Soviet arms control proposal. They may suggest a merging of the INF and START talks, but that would not be a constructive step. You have dealt with Moscow for many years -- do you have any suggestions for improving the East-West dialogue?
- -- We are striving to promote the democratic process in Central America and view the El Salvadoran elections as an important step in that process. While providing a security shield for our friends, we believe that stability in the region is ultimately dependent on political reconciliation and economic development.
