Both Bud and John have suggested that we periodically schedule Defense Ministers, hence I think we should support Cap's recommendation.

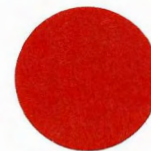

Subject: President's Personal Representative to Inauguration  
of New FRG President Richard von Weizsaecker

Richard von Weizsaecker, who has had a long and distinguished political career in the Federal Republic of Germany and whose most recent post was as Governing Mayor of Berlin, was elected May 23 to be the FRG's sixth Federal President. Weizsaecker is a good friend of the U.S. and is expected to use his position to represent vigorously the Western goals we and the Germans share. He will be inaugurated in Bonn on July 1, 1984.

Senator Charles McC. Mathias (R-Md.) has been invited to attend the ceremony by Weizsaecker himself, who said that he was "strongly interested in having his good friend" represent the United States. Since it was known some time ago that Weizsaecker would be elected, we already knew from Mathias that he was planning to go. We have now confirmed with his staff that he is still planning to accept the invitation and that he would be delighted to be the President's personal representative.

Please advise whether the Senator can be so designated. We are working on an appointment for him with Chancellor Kohl. If the meeting can be arranged, we propose that Mathias be given a Presidential message to deliver to Kohl. We will be working on a draft closer to the date.
