SUBJECT: Ambassador Hermes Requests An Appointment

As we discussed, German Ambassador Peter Hermes has asked to pay a farewell call on you and the President. I do not believe a call on the President is warranted. Ambassadors normally do not call on the President prior to leaving Washington and there is no compelling reason to spend a scheduling chip on Hermes.

Hermes' next assignment is as the German Ambassador to the Vatican and I hope you can fit him in for a brief call.

RECOMMENDATION

1. That you agree that we not seek an appointment for Hermes with the President.
