MOW THAT THE FIVE ARE CONTEMPLATING THE PREPARATION OF PROPOSALS FOR CONSTITUTIONAL PRINCIPLES RATHER THEN DRAFT CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS AS SUCH, THE CONTENTS AND SCOPE OF THE UK PAPER HAVE BEEN SUBSTANTIALLY RE-CAST. OUR INTENTION AND HOPE ARE THAT THE PAPER MAY PROVE USE-FUL FOR THE WORKING GROUP OF OFFICIALS OF THE FIVE WHICH WAS TO HAVE MET IN WASHINGTON ON 24 AUGUST. DESPITE THE PUSTPUMEMENT OF THAT MEETING, WE THOUGHT YOUR GOVERNMENT MIGHT FIND IT USEFUL TO HAVE THE PAPER NOW. WE SHOULD DP COURSE WELCOME YOUR GOVERNMENT'S COMMENTS IN ADVANCE OF THE ASHINGTON MEETING AS A MEANS OF RESOLVING SOME OF THE QUESTIONS THAT NEED TO BE CONSIDERED.
