WE ARE NOT SAYING WHAT THE OUTCOME OF THIS PROCESS SHOULD BE -- THAT IS INDEED THE BUSINESS OF THE POLISH PEOPLE. BUT WE HAVE A RIGHT -- EVEN AN OBLIGATION --- UNDER THE HELSINKI ACCORDS TO ACT TO ENSURE THAT A PROCESS SUPPORTED BY THE OVERWHELMING MAJORITY OF THE POLISH PEOPLE IS RESUMED. IN PARTICULAR WE HAVE AN -OBLIGATION TO ENSURE THAT THE EXTERNAL AND INTERNAL PRESSURES TO CRUSH THIS PROCESS ARE OFFSET BY PRESSURES FROM THE WEST ON THE SIDE OF THE POLISH PEOPLE - THEMSELVES.

THIS IS NOT AN UNREALISTIC OBJECTIVE. JARUZELSKI OR ANY FUTURE LEADERSHIP NEEDS AT LEAST MINIMAL SUPPORT FROM THE PEOPLE TO PUT POLAND BACK ON ITS FEET. HE ALREADY IS PAYING LIP SERVICE TO THIS NEED. BUT THE WEST HAS AN INDISPENSABLE ROLE TO PLAY IN INCREASING HIS INCENTIVES FOR MEANINGFUL ACTS OF ACCOMODATION. WE ALSO HAVE A CRITICAL ROLE TO PLAY IN MAKING CLEAR TO THE SOVIETS THE CONSEQUENCES AND COSTS OF THEIR CONTINUING TO PREVENT A PROCESS OF RECONCILIATION AND NEGOTIATION.

FAILURE TO ACT VIS-A-VIS THE SOVIETS COULD BE EVEN MORE COSTLY IN TERMS OF BROAD EAST-WEST RELATIONS THAN A FAILURE TO TAKE MEASURES DIRECTED AT JARUZELSKI.

FIRST, WE DON'T BELIEVE THAT A REPRESSED POLAND IS A FACTOR FOR STABILITY IN EUROPE. THERE MUST BE A PROCESS OF REFORM AND CONSENSUS-BUILDING FOR ANY GENUINE AND DURABLE STABILITY TO EMERGE, AND THE SOVIET UNION MUST BE BROUGHT TO RECOGNIZE THIS FACT. OTHERWISE WE ARE HEADED FOR A PERMANENT ARMED-CAMP AND ULTIMATE PROSPECT OF VIOLENT REVOLT IN THE EAST. IN

SUM, GRADUAL REFORM AND MODERNIZATION WITHIN THE EAST IS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH CONSTRUCTIVE EAST-WEST RELATIONS -- INDEED IT IS ONE OF THE PREMISES OF IMPROVED RELATIONS AND GREATER STABILITY IN EUROPE

SECOND, A FAILURE TO ACT WITH REGARD TO THE USE OF FORCE TO STOP 18 MONTHS OF ENTIRELY PEACEFUL DIALOGUE IN POLAND -- ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT AND CONSTRUCTIVE DEVELOPMENTS IN THE POSTWAR WORLD -- WOULD SEND THE SOVIET UNION THE WRONG SIGNAL ABOUT OUR REACTIONS TO FUTURE EVENTS IN EUROPE AND ELSEWHERE. TO AVOID FUTURE MISUNDERSTANDING WHICH COULD LEAD TO DISASTER, THIS ADMINISTRATION HAS BEEN TRYING TO CONVINCE THE SOVIETS THAT WE ARE PREDICTABLE, THAT THERE WILL BE BOTH NEGATIVE AND POSITIVE CONSEQUENCES DEPENDING UPON THEIR CONDUCT. WE HAVE DECIDED NOT TO MAKE FURTHER PUBLIC EXPOSITIONS OF OUR POSITION ON THE EIGHT POINTS AND WE ARE INFORMING BOTH THE ISRAELIS AND THE SAUDIS THAT IT IS IN NO ONE'S INTEREST FOR THEM CONTINUALLY TO PUT US IN THE POSTURE OF HAVING TO RESPOND TO HIGH VISIBILITY OFFICIAL PUBLIC STATEMENTS WHICH AT LEAST BY IMPLICATION PROFESS TO ADDRESS THE AMERICAN POSITION.

YOUR CUPRENT VISIT TO SAUDI ARABIA WILL KEEP A PUBLIC FOCUS ON THE EIGHT POINTS. I HOPE YOU WILL KEEP IN MIND OUR VIEWS AND IF APPROPRIATE REINFORCE THEM WITH OUR SAUDI FRIENDS.

IN THIS RESPECT, OUR EMBASSY IN TEL AVIV REPORTS THAT THE MODD IN ISRAEL IS ABOUT AS BLACK AND THREATENING AS IT EVER HAS BEEN. I CAN ASSURE YOU THAT WE ARE DOING OUR UTMOST TO CALM THE ISRAELIS AND TO ENSURE THAT THIS MODD DOES NOT TRANSLATE INTO HARMFUL INITIATIVES OR UNANTICIPATED SURPRISES. (YOU ARE AWARE OF MY LONG-STANDING CONCERN OVER A POSSIBLE ISRAELI MOVE INTO LEBANON.) IN THIS RESPECT, I BFLIEVE IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT, WHATEVER YOUR BILATERAL DISCUSSIONS WITH THE SAUDIS MAY BE ON FAHD'S EIGHT POINTS, THESE PROPOSALS NOT BE REFLECTED OR LINKED IN ANY WAY TO THE FORTH-COMING STATEMENT CONCERNING EC PARTICIPATION IN THE SINAI PEACEKEEPING FORCE. AT THIS POINT, SUCH A DEVELOPMENT WOULD MAKE THE VOLATILE ISRAELI SITUATION EVEN MORE UNPREDICTABLE.

I OD HOPE YOU HAVE USEFUL AND PRODUCTIVE DISCUSSIONS WITH THE SAUDIS AND WOULD APPRECIATE RECEIVING YOUR ANALYSIS OF THE RESULTS OF YOUR VISIT. END TEXT.

  2. CARRINGTON HAS SPOKEN OF A "SMALL PRICE" HE WILL WANT IN RETURN FOR BRITISH AND EC PARTICIPATION IN THE MFO. WE ARE CONCERNED THAT HIS PRICE WILL BE TOO HIGH. - 5. OUR IMPRESSION IS THAT THE FRENCH, ITALIANS AND AUSTRALIANS APE NOT PARTICULARLY INCLINED TO ASK FOR ANYT; ING IN RETURN FOR THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THIS FORCE.
