5. KING ASKED FOR RECONFIRMATION US STILL CONSIDERED EAST JERUSALEM AS PART OF TRITORIES OCCUPIED BY ISRAEL IN 1967 WAR. ASSETS IN AREA TO FRUSTRATE INITIATIVE. THIS MEANS SYRIA WILL NOT ONLY BE NEGATIVE BUT PROBABLY MILITARILY THREAT-ENING TO JORDAN. IN COURSE BRIEF EXCHANGE ON SECURITY ISSUES, I ASSURED KING OF OUR SUPPORT IN SUCH CIRCUMSTANCES AND EMPHASIZED POSITIVE IMPACT OUR BEING PARTNERS IN NEW PEACE VENTURE WOULD HAVE ON PROSPECTS OR HILL SUPPORT FOR UPCOMING MAJOR JORDAN ARMS PACKAGE. 

3. ARRANGEMENTS DESCRIBED BY ICRC TRACK CLOSELY WITH WHAT WE HAVE BEEN TOLD BY HMG DEPARTMENT OF TRADE (REFS D AND E). AS REPORTED IN REF D BRITISH HAVE OUTLINED TWO POSSIBILITIES FOR FINANCIAL TRANSFERS: A) BOARD OF TRADE WOULD OPEN SPECIAL SUB ACCOUNT WITH BANK OF ENGLAND'S FEDERAL RESERVE ACCOUNT IN NEW YORK. ICRC WOULD THEN TRANSFER \$2 HILLION INTO THIS ACCOUNT WHICH BRITISH COULD USE AS SOON AS SHIPS ARE IDENTIFIED AND TERMS AGREED WITH USG. THIS FROCEDURE IS PREFERRED AS IT WOULD SPARE BRITISH FROM THE NEED TO MAKE A SERIES OF TRANSACTIONS FROM DOLLARS TO POUNDS WHICH WOULD BE REQUIRED IN THE FOLLOWING OPTION; B) THE BDARD OF TRADE COULD OPEN A SUSPENSE ACCOUNT WITH THE MERCANTILE SHIP EXCHANGE IN CHOON INTO WHICH ICRC WOULD DEPOSIT FUNDS. THESE FUNDS WOULD HAVE TO BE DEPOSITED IN STERLING. 4. THE BRITISH NEED ONE QUESTION ANSWERED BEFORE THEY WOULD WISH TO OPEN EITHER TYPE OF ACCOUNT. 





WE WOULD LIKE TO SEE IT WORK, BUT A ONE-SIDED SECURITY COUNCIL DEBATE, OR A RESOLUTION IF THAT EMERGES, FOCUSING ON ONLY ONE NARROW ISSUE -- THE NICARAGUAN HONDURAN BORDER -- WOULD MAKE THAT MUCH MORE DIFFICULT. -- (FOR CARACAS) YOUHAVE TAKEN THE LEAD IN DEVELOPING THE '5/5' CONFERENCE; DESPITE SOME MISGIVINGS, WE HAVE HEEDED YOUR APPEAL NOT TO OPPOSE IT. -- THE UNITED STATES IS COMMITTED TO FINDING A SOLUTION TO THESE REGIONAL ISSUES THROUGH REGIONAL APPROACHES. I WANT YOU TO KNOW THAT, FOR OUR PART, WE WILL CONTINUE OUR EFFORTS TO PRESS FOR REASONABLE SOUTH AFRICAN BEHAVIOR AND RESTRAINT ON ANGOLA WHILE OTHER PRESSURES MOUNT DN THE ANGOLANS TO NEGOTIATE SERIOUSLY. ONE SUBJECT WHICH I WILL WANT TO DISCUSS BOTH BILATERALLY WITH YOU DURING MY VISIT TO LONDON AS WELL

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

AS AT OUR DECEMBER 8 DINNER IS HOW WE SHOULD FOLLOW-UP TO THE CONSENSUS ON EAST-WEST ECONOMIC RELATIONS CONTAINED IN THE "SUMMARY OF CONCLUSIONS." AS YOU

KNOW, THIS IS A MATTER TO WHICH THE PRESIDENT ATTACHES GREAT IMPORTANCE, AND I BELIEVE IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT WE AGREE AMONG OURSELVES ON HOW WE SHOULD MOVE AHEAD IN THE VARIOUS AREAS ENUMERATED IN THE "SUMMARY OF CONCLUSIONS."

WHILE I DO NOT WISH TO GO INTO THEM IN DETAIL AT THIS TIME, I THOUGHT IT WOULD BE USEFUL TO PREPARE FOR OUR MEETING IF I GAVE YOU SOME IDEA OF HOW WE ENVISAGE THE FOLLOW-UP PROCESS DEVELOPING. AS A GENERAL RULE, WE BELIEVE THE SEVEN-NATION GROUP, WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF THE EC PRESIDENCY AND THE COMMISSION, WHICH WORKED TOGETHER SO EFFECTIVELY, SHOULD CONTINUE TO BE USED IN SOME WAY TO COORDINATE THE FOLLOW-UP PROCESS. AT THE SAME TIME, WE RECOGNIZE THE DESIRABILITY OF USING EXISTING INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS WHENEVER POSSIBLE, AND WE WOULD MINIMIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ANY NEW INSTITUTIONS EITHER TO CONDUCT THE FOLLOW-UP WORK OR AS A RESULT OF THAT WORK.

TO ENSURE THAT OUR ECONOMIC RELATIONS WITH THE SOVIET UNION ARE CONSISTENT WITH OUR STRATEGIC INTERESTS, WE SHOULD GO FORWARD WITH OUR AGREEMENT TO CONDUCT EXPEDITIOUSLY AN OVERALL STUDY ON EAST-WEST ECONOMIC RELATIONS. WE ENVISAGE THIS STUDY VERY MUCH ALONG LINES DEVELOPED IN THE "SUMMARY OF CONCLUSIONS." I REMEMBER THAT WE ALL ATTACHED GREAT IMPORTANCE TO THIS EFFORT, AS IT WILL PROVIDE US WITH A COMMON ASSESSMENT OF EAST-WEST ECONOMIC RELATIONS AND THEREBY ENABLE US TO IMPLEMENT THE PRINCIPLES ON WHICH WE AGREED. IN OUR VIEW, A SPECIAL GROUP SHOULD BE FORMED TO CONDUCT THIS STUDY ON THE BASIS OF CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES. THIS GROUP COULD WELL CALL UPON THE DECD AND NATO FOR CONTRIBUTIONS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE AREAS OF EXPERTISE. A SECRETARIAT ROLE FOR

ONE OF THESE INSTITUTIONS (OR THE TWO JOINTLY) IS ALSO A POSSIBILITY TO BE EXPLORED.

FINALLY, IT IS CLEAR TO US THAT SOME INFORMAL MECHANISM WILL BE NEEDED TO SUPERVISE THE FOLLOW-UP PROCESS AS A WHOLE. THE WASHINGTON AMBASSADORIAL GROUP HAS SERVED WELL IN THIS CAPACITY, BUT WE MAY WANT NOW TO CONSIDER OTHER POSSIBILITIES.

I THINK YOU WILL AGREE THAT, AS FAR AS EAST-WEST ECONOMIC RELATIONS ARE CONCERNED, WHILE MUCH OF THE SUBSTANCE OF OUR CONSULTATIONS HAS CONCERNED MATTERS DEALT WITH IN OTHER BODIES, IT NEVERTHELESS IS IMPORTANT THAT NATO HAVE A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN THE ON-GOING CONSULTATIVE PROCESS. 1. THE EMBASSY IS REQUESTED TO TRANSMIT THE FOLLOWING LETTER CONCERNING THE GATT MINISTERIAL FROM SECRETARY SHULTZ TO SECRETARY PYM. FOR YOUR INFORMATION, THE SECRETARY IS ALSO WRITING EC PRESIDENT THORN, AS WELL AS THE FOREIGN MINISTERS OF SEVERAL OTHER GATT-MEMBER COUNTRIES, INCLUDING SOME EC MEMBER-STATES, TO EXPRESS HIS VIEWS ON THE PRINCIPAL ISSUES FACING THE MINISTERIAL, AND TO URGE THAT GREATER EFFORTS BE MADE TO ASSURE A PRODUCTIVE MEETING.

#### 2. TEXT OF LETTER TO PYM:

DEAR FRANCIS:

#### MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

THE-UNITED KINGDOM AND THE UNITED STATES HAVE A COMMON INTEREST-IN A STRONG AND EQUITABLE MULTILATERAL TRADE SYSTEM. IN ORDER TO SUSTAIN AND IMPROVE THIS SYSTEM, PARTICULARLY DURING THE CURRENT PERIOD OF SERIOUS TRADE

TENSION, WE ALSO HAVE A MUTUAL STAKE IN PROMOTING EFFECTIVE INTERNATIONAL TRADE RULES. THE WELL-BEING OF THE INSTITU-TION WE COOPERATIVELY DEVELOPED TO ADMINISTER THESE RULES, THE GATT, IS OF MAJOR CONCERN TO BOTH OF US. THESE SHARED INTERESTS PROMPT ME TO REGUEST YOUR PERSONAL ASSISTANCE IN ASSURING A PRODUCTIVE OUTCOME FOR THE GATT MINISTERIAL MEETING IN NOVEMBER.

I AM ENCOURAGED THAT WE ARE IN GENERAL AGREEMENT ON THE IMPORTANCE OF A SUCCESSFUL MINISTERIAL. HOWEVER, WITH THE MEETING ONLY A FEW WEEKS AWAY, AND WITH PROTECTIONIST PRESSURES IN MANY COUNTRIES INTENSIFYING, I AM CONCERNED THAT WE MUST DO MORE TO ASSURE A SUCCESSFUL OUTCOME. IF THE MINISTERIAL DOES NOT ACHIEVE MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL RESULTS, WHICH DEMONSTRATE THAT THE GATT CAN ADDRESS SOME OF THE TRADE SYSTEM'S PRESSING PROBLEMS, IT SEEMS TO ME THAT THE RISK OF A SERIOUS DETERIORATION IN WORLD TRADE RELATIONS IS VERY GRAVE.

I AM PLEASED AT THE PROGRESS WE HAVE MADE TOWARD A WORK PROGRAM ON SERVICES. I KNOW THAT WE SHARE A STRONG INTEREST IN AN OPEN INTERNATIONAL REGIME FOR SERVICES, AND APPRECIATE THE SUPPORT YOU HAVE GIVEN TO OUR INITIATIVE.

THERE ARE THREE OTHER AREAS, HOWEVER, IN WHICH I BELIEVE IT-IS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT FOR-THE MINISTERIAL TO MAKE PROGRESS. THE FIRST IS SAFEGUARDS. WITHOUT AN UNDER-STANDING ON THE TYPE OF MEASURES A COUNTRY CAN LEGITI-MATELY TAKE WHEN ONE OF ITS INDUSTRIES FACES INJURY FROM IMPORTS, THE CONCEPT OF A STANDSTILL ON PROTECTIVE MEASURES WILL NOT FIND SUPPORT. AT THE SAME TIME, IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT WE FIND A SOLUTION TO THE PROBLEM OF SELECTIVE SAFEGUARDS, WHICH DEVELOPING COUNTRIES PERCEIVE AS A MAJOR THREAT TO THEIR MARKET ACCESS. I AM CONVINCED THAT UNLESS WE CONCLUDE A SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT WITH SELECTIVITY PROVISIONS ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES, WE WILL LOSE THE IMPACT WE NEED FROM THE POLITICAL STATEMENT BY THE GATT MINISTERS. IT SEEMS TO ME THAT SECRETARY GENERAL DUNKEL'S PROPOSAL CONTAINS THE

ELEMENTS OF A SOLUTION TO THIS PROBLEM, AND I URGE YOU TO GIVE IT YOUR SUPPORT. UNILATERAL SELECTIVITY CANNOT BE THE BASIS OF A VIABLE SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT.

THE SECOND AREA WHICH THE MINISTERIAL MUST ADDRESS IS AGRICULTURAL TRADE, INCLUDING IN PARTICULAR THE USE OF AGRICULTURAL EXPORT SUBSIDIES. THE LONG-STANDING POLICY DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE COMMUNITY ARE WELL KNOWN TO YOU. I APPRECIATE THAT IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO RESOLVE THESE DIFFERENCES BEFORE THE

MINISTERIAL. HOWEVER, IT IS VITAL THAT WE AGREE ON A METHOD FOR DISCUSSING THESE ISSUES WITHIN THE GATT. IN ADDITION, WE MUST AGREE TO INITIATE GATT DISCUSSIONS WHICH PERMIT SIGNIFICANT PROGRESS TOWARD RESOLVING THESE PROBLEMS IN THE RELATIVELY NEAR TERM. IF WE CANNOT TAKE THESE STEPS I AM CONCERNED THAT THE FRUSTRATION OF PRO-DUCER GROUPS WITH THE TRADING SYSTEM WILL PROVE DAMAGING TO US ALL.

FINALLY, IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT WE MAKE PROGRESS TOWARD INTEGRATING DEVELOPING COUNTRIES BETTER INTO THE TRADING SYSTEM. ONE ASPECT OF THIS EFFORT IS SAFEGUARDS, ANOTHER IS THE PROPOSAL WHICH WE HAVE PUT FORWARD FOR A ROUND OF TRADE NEGOTIATIONS WITH DEVELOPING COUNTRIES. WE WOULD LIKE TO HAVE YOUR ACTIVE SUPPORT IN DEVELOPING A MORE DETAILED NEGOTIATING PROGRAM AND IN PERSUADING DEVELOPING COUNTRIES WITH A LARGE STAKE IN TRADE THAT SUCH NEGOTIATIONS WOULD BE STRONGLY IN THEIR INTEREST.

DEAR FRANCIST

AS I AM SURE SIR OLIVER WRIGHT HAS INFORMED YOU, THE FIRST MEETING OF THE UK, FRG AND FRENCH AMBASSADORS WITH LARPY EAGLEBURGER, ALLEN WALLIS AND RICK BURT YESTERDAY AFTERNOON PROCEEDED MORE OR LESS AS EXPECTED. WE DEEPLY APPRECIATE THE EXTREMELY HELPFUL POSITION TAKEN BY SIR OLIVER AT THAT MEETING. HE WAS ABLE, THROUGH HIS INTERVENTIONS IN THE DISCUSSION, TO MOVE MATTERS AHEAD AT SEVERAL POINTS, AND WE WERE VERY GRATEFUL FOR YOUR HELP.

AS EXPECTED, THE FRENCH POSITION REMAINS THE KEY TO SUCCESS IN THESE DISCUSSIONS. I AM MODERATELY ENCOURAGED BY THE FACT THAT, AT THE END OF THE DAY, THE FRENCH AMBASSADOP WAS AT LEAST PREPARED TO ACCEPT MY NON-PAPER AS THE BASIS FOR FURTHER DISCUSSIONS. DISCUSSIONS WE HAD IN NEW YORK AND AT LA SAPINIERE.

AS YOU MAY KNOW BY NOW, WE HAVE ARRANGED FOR LARRY EAGLEBURGER, ALLEN WALLIS AND RICK BURT TO MEET WITH THE AMBASSADORS OF OUR SMALLER GROUP ON THURSDAY MORNING. WE ARE ALSO ARRANGING A SUBSEQUENT MEETING ON FRIDAY AFTERNOON WITH THE AMBASSADORS OF THE ECONOMIC SUMMIT COUNTRIES TO WHICH THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DANISH PRESIDENCY AND THE HEAD OF THE EC COMMISSION REPRESENTATION IN WASHINGTON WILL ALSO BE INVITED. CONSEQUENTLY, I BELIEVE THAT IN PROCEDURAL TERMS THE FOLLOW-UP PROCESS IS WELL UNDERWAY.







2. EMBASSY SHOULD DELIVER FOLLOWING LETTER FROM THE SECRETARY TO FOREIGN MINISTER AFTER ADDING APPROPRIATE PERSONAL SALUTATIONS. THERE WILL BE NO SIGNED ORIGINAL.

#### 3. BEGIN TEXT:

DEAR ----:

.. NOW THAT I- HAVE HAD TIME TO REFLECT ON MY MEETINGS WITH GROMYKO, I WANT TO GIVE YOU SOME OF MY PERSONAL IMPRESSIONS. THIS WILL SUPPLEMENT OUR RECENT

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

CONVERSATIONS AND THE DETAILED ØRIEFINGS YOUR AMØASSADORS HAVE RECEIVED IN WASHINGTON AND BRUSSELS. ... BOTH MEETINGS WERE SOBER AND SUBSTANTIVE, WITH A MINIMUM OF GROMYKD'S USUAL POLEMICS. INDEED, I WAS

IMPRESSED THAT HE DID NOT PUSH ANY OF THE PROPAGANDISTIC ARMS CONTROL PROPOSALS CONTAINED IN HIS UNGA SPEECH, AND AGREED THAT THE INF AND START TALKS ARE PROCEEDING IN A SERIOUS MANNER. NOR DID HE EVEN MENTION BREZHNEV'S SIX POINT MIDDLE EAST PROPOSAL, THOUGH HE DID SPEAK AT LENGTH ABOUT OUR ALLEGED EFFORTS TO EXCLUDE MOSCOW FROM THE AREA.

.. AS YOU KNOW, THE PRESIDENT AND I HAD DECIDED BEFORE THE MEETINGS TO PLACE PARTICULAR EMPHASIS ON HUMAN RIGHTS. GROMYKO'S RESPONSE WAS PREDICTABLY HARD, EMPHASIZING THAT THE STATE HAD TO HAVE THE FINAL WORD IN SUCH CASES. ON POLAND, AFGHANISTAN AND ARMS CONTROL ISSUES, GROMYKO'S STATEMENTS WERE ALMOST ENTIRELY STANDARD FARE.

.. DURING THE SECOND MEETING, I SUGGESTED THAT WE CONCENTRATE ON TRYING TO MAKE PROGRESS IN A FEW SPECIFIC AND LIMITED AREAS, SOME OF WHICH HAVE BEEN UNDER DISCUSSION BY OUR EXPERTS. ON HUMAN RIGHTS, GROMYKO AGREED TO MY PROPOSAL THAT OUR NEGOTIATORS GET TOGETHER PRIOR TO RESUMPTION OF THE MADRID MEETING FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION OF THIS SUBJECT, THE MADRID CSCE MEETING AND OTHER ISSUES.

.. AT MY SUGGESTION, GROMYKO AND I ALSO AGREED THAT US-SOVIET BILATERAL DISCUSSIONS SHOULD CONTINUE ON THE NAMIBIA/ANGOLA ISSUES. AS YOU KNOW, ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF STATE CROCKER HAS HAD TWO MEETINGS WITH THE SOVIETS AT DEPUTY MINISTER LEVEL ON THESE ISSUES, AND WE WILL BE SUGGESTING THAT ANOTHER 'XCHANGE TAKE PLACE IN MOSCOW IN NOVEMBER. I AM CONSIDERING HAVING CROCKER JOIN AMBASSADOR HARTMAN FOR THESE DISCUSSIONS, WHICH WOULD FOCUS ON A RENEWED EFFORT TO GAIN SOVIET COOPERATION WITH THE CONTACT GROUP'S EFFORTS.

.. ON NON-PROLIFERATION, GROMYKO AND I DISCUSSED INTENSIFICATION OF ALREADY EXISTING US-SOVIET BILATERAL CONTACTS. AT THE RECENT IAEA GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AMBASSADOR RICHARD KENNEDY SUGGESTED TO HIS SOVIET

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

COUNTERPART THAT A ROUND OF EXPERT-LEVEL CONSULTATIONS ON NON-PROLIFERATION TAKE PLACE IN WASHINGTON NEXT MONTH. I REITERATED THIS INVITATION TO GROMYKO, AND WE AGREED TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THIS PROPOSAL.

.. NONE OF THESE MODEST STEPS COULD BE CONSIDERED A BREAKTHROUGH; INDEED EACH OF THESE AVENUES OF DIALOGUE IS IN THE EXPLORATORY STAGE. NEVERTHELESS, I BELIEVE THIS WILL ALLOW US TO DISCUSS A FEW AREAS WHERE PROGRESS MIGHT BE POSSIBLE.

.. GROMYKO AND I DID NOT DISCUSS THE POSSIBILITY OF A SUMMIT. WE DID CONSIDER ANOTHER MEETING ØETWEEN US, BUT THIS WAS LEFT UNTIL WE SEE HOW OUR RELATIONS DEVELOP IN THE MONTHS AHEAD.

.. MY OVERALL ASSESSMENT IS THAT BOTH GROMYKO AND I WERE OPERATING ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN US ARE LARGE AND DEEP, AND THAT PROGRESS WILL BE DIFFICULT. I THINK THIS IS AN ACCURATE REFLECTION OF THE OVERALL STATE OF OUR RELATIONSHIP BECAUSE OF SOVIET ØEHAVIOR AND OUR DIFFERENCES ON SO MANY ESSENTIALS. 2. PRIOR TO SEPTEMBER 17 EVENTS IN BONN, BRITISH EMBASSY HAS ADVISED DEPARTMENT THAT FIVE-NATION FOREIGN MINISTERS MEETING COULD NOT TAKE PLACE AS SUGGESTED SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 26 BETWEEN 2:00 AND 4:00 DUE TO GENSCHER'S TRAVEL PLANS. BRITISH ALSO ADVISED THAT

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

CHEYSSON IS STILL RELUCTANT TO MEET DUE TO ALLEGED "DISCRIMINATION" AGAINST CREUSOT-LOIRE AND BECAUSE HE BELIEVES EUROPEANS SHOULD NOT BE SEEN AS TAKING INITIATIVE IN THIS MATTER. WE HAVE ASKED EMBASSY PARIS TO CLARIFY SITUATION REGARDING CREUSOT-LOIRE DENIAL ORDER TO MAKE CLEAR TO THE FRENCH THAT NO "DISCRIMINATION" IS INVOLVED IN NARROWING SCOPE OF ORIGINAL DENIAL ORDER AGAINST CREUSOT-LOIRE BUT THAT DELAY IN TAKING THIS ACTION RESULTED FROM LEGAL STEPS OF CREUSOT-LOIRE'S ATTORNEYS.

3. ON OTHER ISSUE OF WHETHER EUROPEANS SHOULD BE SEEN AS TAKING INITIATIVE, THE SECRETARY'S POSITION REMAINS THAT HE IS PREPARED TO MEET WITH HIS EUROPEAN COLLEAGUES FOR A PRELIMINARY DISCUSSION OF THE SANCTIONS QUESTION AND RELATED MATTERS IF THEY WISH TO MEET WITH HIM. HE WILL BE SEEING ALL OF THEM BILATERALLY DURING THE UNGA AND THERE WILL BE SEVERAL MULTILATERAL MEETINGS IN NEW YORK AS WELL AS THE NATO FOREIGN MINISTERS MEETING AT LA SAPPINERE. IT IS CLEAR FROM THE BRITISH EMBASSY CONTACTS WITH US THAT FOREIGN SECRETARY PYM CONTINUES TO FEEL THAT A FIVE-NATION MEETING, PERHAPS INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EC PRESIDENCY AND THE COMMISION, WOULD BE DESIRABLE. PYM PLANS TO DISCUSS THE SUBJECT FURTHER WITH CHEYSSON AND HIS OTHER COLLEAGUES AT THE SEPTEMBER 2Ø EC FOREIGN MINISTERS MEETING; HE IS ALSO SCHEDULED TO MEET WITH CHEYSSON BILATERALLY ON SEPTEMBER 22. THE BRITISH ASSUME THAT CHEYSSON WILL NOT AGREE FINALLY TO A MEETING UNTIL AFTER HIS BILATERAL MEETING WITH THE SECRETARY, WHICH IS SCHEDULED FOR SUNDAY EVENING SEPTEMBER 26. THEY ARE PERFECTLY RELAXED ABOUT ALLOWING CHEYSSON TO TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR MAKING THE MEETING POSSIBLE, IF THIS IS INDEED CHEYSSON'S PLAN.

5. UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES, THE SECRETARY INTENDS TO

AWAIT FURTHER WORD FROM HIS EUROPEAN COLLEAGUES REGARDING THEIR DISCUSSIONS AND DESIRES, AND WE DO NOT PLAN TO TAKE ANY STEPS TO ORGANIZE A MEETING. WHILE THE BRITISH ARE PREPARED TO BE HELPFUL, THEY DO NOT WISH TO BECOME TOO EXPOSED ON THIS MATTER, WHICH IS QUITE UNDERSTANDABLE, AND WE DO NOT WISH TO MAKE THINGS ANY MORE DIFFICULT FOR FRANCIS PYM IN HIS TALKS WITH CHEYSSON AND OTHERS. CONSEQUENTLY, IF ASKED BY THE PRESS REGARDING THE POSSIBILITIES OF A MEETING IN NEW YORK ON THIS SUBJECT WITH THE OTHER FOUR FOREIGN MINISTERS, WE HAVE INSTRUCTED DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN TO SAY THAT DURING THE PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 26 TO ROUGHLY OCTOBER 6 THE SECRETARY WILL BE SEEING HIS EUROPEAN COUNTERPARTS BILATERALLY AND MULTILATERALLY IN NEW YORK AND LA SAPPINERE AND THAT IT IS POSSIBLE DURING THIS PERIOD THAT SUCH A MEETING MIGHT BE ORGANIZED. 2. SUMMARY. THIS MESSAGE SUMMARIZES FOR AMBASSADORS' BACKGROUND ONLY WHERE WE ARE IN OUR ANGOLA/NAMIBIA INITIATIVES SO THAT YOU WILL BE IN AN INFORMED POSITION TO SUPPORT THE EFFORT AS APPROPRIATE. END SUMMARY.

3. AS WE MOVE INTO WHAT CAN BE THE FINAL, DECISIVE WEEKS OF NEGOTIATIONS ON THE ANGOLA/NAMIBIA QUESTION, I WANT TO BRING YOU UP TO DATE ON WHERE WE ARE SO THAT YOU WILL BE IN A POSITION TO SUPPORT-OUR EFFORTS. OVER THE PAST MONTH THE NEGOTIATIONS HAVE INTENSIFIED ON ALL FRONTS: WITH THE ANGOLANS, WITH THE FRONT LINE STATES (FLS) AND THE UN IN NEW YORK, AND WITH THE SOUTH AFRICANS. EVENTS WILL MOVE EVEN MORE QUICKLY IN THE DAYS AND WEEKS AHEAD. THE PHASE II DISCUSSIONS WITH THE FLS AND UN IN NEW YORK HAVE BEEN VIRTUALLY COMPLETED. FINAL DETAILS REGARDING UNTAG COMPOSITION AND DEPLOYMENT

REMAIN TO BE RESOLVED, AND THE ELECTORAL SYSTEM FINESSE MUST BE WORKED OUT, BUT THESE ARE NOT MAJOR PROBLEMS. THE CONTACT GROUP (CG) COULD BE READY TO SEEK WITHIN THE NEXT SEVERAL WEEKS A RESOLUTION FROM THE SECURITY COUNCIL TO IMPLEMENT UNSCR 435, IF AGREEMENT CAN BE REACHED WITH THE ANGOLANS ON THE CUBAN WITHDRAWAL QUESTION. THE FOCUS OF OUR EFFORTS, THEREFORE, IS ON OBTAINING AN ACCEPTABLE COMMITMENT FROM THE MPLA ON CUBAN WITHDRAWAL DURING PHASE 111.

4. THE TWO MISSIONS BY GENERAL WALTERS TO ANGOLA IN JUNE AND JULY AGAINST A BACKGROUND OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS AT THE FOREIGN MINISTER LEVEL PLAYED AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN BUILDING MUTUAL CONFIDENCE AND TRUST. THOSE MISSIONS UNDERLINED U.S. SERIOUSNESS IN WORKING WITH THE MPLA TO FIND A REASONABLE SOLUTION TO THE WITHDRAWAL PROBLEM.

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

WALTERS MOVED THE DISCUSSIONS BEYOND EXPLORATION AND SPARRING TO A FRANK AND HIGH-LEVEL DISCUSSION OF ALL ASPECTS OF THE WITHDRAWAL QUESTION. WALTERS' PRESENCE IN ANGOLA AS THE SPECIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PRESIDENT FORCED THE MPLA INTO A MORE INTENSE INTERNAL DEBATE ON ITS BOTTOM LINE ON WITHDRAWAL. PRESIDENT DOS SANTOS APPARENTLY EMERGED WITH A PARTY MANDATE TO PURSUE THE DISCUSSIONS WITH US SEEKING TO WORK OUT A COMPROMISE. WHILE SOME WITHIN THE MPLA ARE EXTREMELY NERVOUS ABOUT THE PROSPECT OF CUBAN WITHDRAWAL, WHICH COULD THREATEN THEIR PERSONAL POSITIONS (I.E. THE HARDLINE MULATTOS AND TRADITIONAL ALLIES OF THE SOVIETS), DOS SANTOS APPEARS TO BE OPERATING ON THE BASIS OF A BROAD MANDATE FROM THE PARTY AS A WHOLE AND HIS STRENGTH AS A CONSENSUS LEADER MAKES HIM A CREDIBLE NEGOTIATOR.

5. THE MISSION WHICH MY SENIOR DEPUTY FRANK WISNER LED TO ANGOLA AUGUST 17 TO 20 MADE PROGRESS ON THE CUBAN WITHDRAWAL QUESTION. THE FACT THATDOS SANTOS MET WISNER FOR TWO HDURS, THE WARMTH OF THE RECEPTION, AND SIX HOURS OF FOLLOW-UP DISCUSSIONS WITH THE PRESIDENT'S SENIOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS ADVISER CARLOS FERNANDES AND FORIGN MINISTER JORGE ALL SIGNALLED MPLA READINESS FOR SERIOUS NEGOTIATION. JORGE'S PRESENCE AT ALL THE MEETINGS PRESENTED A UNITED MPLA FRONT.

6. WISNER CARRIED A TOUGH INTRODUCTORY MESSAGE WHICH LEFT DOS SANTOS WITH NO DOUBT THAT THE DECISIVE MOMENT IN THE NEGOTIATION HAD ARRIVED. HE REVIEWED THE HISTORY OF OUR GOOD FAITH EFFORTS THROUGH A YEAR OF DIALOGUE TO WORK OUT AN UNDERSTANDING ON THE

WITHDRAWAL QUESTION. WISNER WENT ARMED WITH FRESH IDEAS ON HOW ANGOLA'S SECURITY CAN BE ASSURED AS CUBAN WITHDRAWAL TAKES PLACE. DOS SANTOS UNDERLINED THAT ANGOLA WANTS TO MAKE PROGRESS IN RESOLVING THE WITHDRAWAL ISSUE AND APPRECIATES THE URGENCY INVOLVED.

7. THE SECURITY GUARANTEE PACKAGE WHICH WISNER OUTLINED WOULD INVOLVE A FRAMEWORK OF INFORMAL RECIPROCAL

ASSURANCES GIVEN BY ANGOLA AND SOUTH AFRICA RESPECTIVELY TO THE U.S. ANGOLA WOULD COMMIT ITSELF TO WITHDRAWAL DURING PHASE III AND WOULD PROVIDE INFORMATION ON THE TIMING AND NUMBERS: SOUTH AFRICA WOULD PLEDGE RESPECT FOR ANGOLA'S TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY AND SOVEREIGNTY. BOTH SIDES WOULD PLEDGE THEMSELVES TO ABIDE BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE PLAN FOR NAMIBIA. THE ANGOLANS TOOK THE POINT THAT THE DETAILED SCENARIO FOR IMPLEMEN-TATION OF THE UN PLAN FOR NAMIBIA WOULD RESULT IN A NEW, IMPROVED SECURITY SITUATION ON THE GROUND FOR ANGOLA. SOUTH AFRICAN FORCES WOULD BE RESTRICTED TO BASE; THE SOUTH AFRICAN WITHDRAWAL SCHEDULE IS SPECIFIED; A CEASEFIRE WILL BE IN PLACE: AND A FULL UNTAG FORCE WILL BE DEPLOYED. THE US-PROPOSED CEASEFIRE BEFORE IMPLEMENTATION WHICH WOHLD COME INTO EFFECT 30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF IMPLEMENTATION WOULD ALSO CREATE AN IMPROVED SECURITY SITUATION. THE CBI WOULD REQUIRE, AMONG OTHER ELEMENTS, SOUTH AFRICAN WITHDRAWAL FROM ANGOLA AND THE CESSATION OF ALL CROSS-BORDER HOST IL IT LES.

8. WE MADE CLEAR TO THE MPLA THAT MOVEMENT ON CUBAN WITHDRAWAL WOULD MEAN STEADY PROGRESS TOWARDS THE GRADUAL NORMALIZATION OF RELATIONS. THE U.S. WOULD ALSO BE PREPARED TO TAKE THE LEAD WITH OTHER POTENTIAL DONORS IN A BROAD-BASED EFFORT TO ASSIST THE ECONOMIC RECONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF ANGOLA. THIS WAS NOT A CARRDT-WAVING SESSION. HOWEVER, THE ANGOLANS DID NOT PRESS US FOR MORE DETAILS.

9. INSTEAD, THE MPLA FOCUSED ON SPECIFIC SECURITY CONCERNS. THEY SOUGHT CLARIFICATION ON THE CONTENT OF A POSSIBLE SOUTH AFRICAN SECURITY GUARANTEE, BUT DID NOT QUESTION THE GENERAL FRAMEWORK FOR PROVIDING IT. IN ANOTHER APPARENT INDICATION THAT THE MPLA IS THINKING SERIOUSLY ABOUT THE IMPLICATIONS OF WITHDRAWAL, JORGE AND DOS SANTOS PROBED ON THE UNITA QUESTION. WE URGED JORGE TOWARDS A REALISTIC AND PRACTICAL APPROACH, NOTING THAT THE CHANGED SITUATION ON-THE GROUND AS A RESULT OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UN PLAN WILL INEVITABLY

MODIFY THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN SOUTH AFRICA AND UNITA

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

WHICH THE MPLA ALLEGES TO EXIST. INTER ALIA, WE UNDER-SCORED THE POINT THAT UNITA WILL CONTINUE TO OPERATE EVEN IF SOUTH AFRICA SUPPORT IS REDUCED OR ENDED AND THAT THE ONLY REALISTIC WAY OF RESOLVING THAT PROBLEM IS THROUGH AN INTERNAL ACCOMMODATION. JORGE LISTENED CLOSELY AND TOOK THE POINTS ON UNITA.

10. THE ANGOLANS HAVE PROMISED TO GET BACK TO US ON AN URGENT BASIS WITH MORE DETAILED IDEAS ON CUBAN WITHDRAWAL. WE LEFT NO DOUBT THAT THE NAMIBIA PROCESS WOULD BOG DOWN IF PROGRESS IS NOT MADE SOON ON THE WITHDRAWAL ISSUE. THIS, WE POINTED OUT, WAS NOT A THREAT OR A DEADLINE BUT SIMPLY THE REALITY -- WE CANNOT KEEP THE PARTIES, ESPECIALLY SOUTH AFRICA, ENGAGED MUCH LONGER IF THERE IS NO MOVEMENT ON ANGOLA'S PART. THERE IS, IN -----EFFECT, A CRACK IN THE ANGOLAN POSITION -- THEY HAVE MOVED BEYOND THE INTRANSIGENCE OF THE ANGOLA-CUBAN COMMUNIQUE OF FEBRUARY 4, 1982 WHICH STATED THAT CUBAN WITHDRAWAL COULD OCCUR ONLY AFTER A NAMIBIA SETTLEMENT. THE MPLA IS NOW ACTIVELY CONSIDERING THE POSSIBILITY OF WITHDRAWAL DURING PHASE III.

11. WE ARE UNDER NO ILLUSIONS. THE MPLA HAS NOT YET MADE ANY COMMITMENT ON NUMBERS OR TIMING. DOS SANTOS FRANKLY SAID THAT ANGOLA WOULD HAVE TO CONSULT WITH THE FLS AND ITS FRIENDS (I.E. THE CUBANS AND SOVIETS) AND ARRIVE AT AN INTERNAL CONSENSUS. IN THE DAYS AND WEEKS AHEAD THERE MAY BE INTENSIFIED SOVIET PRESSURE ON THE MPLA NOT TD COMPROMISE. SOME OF THIS MAY BE DONE THROUGH DISINFORMATION EXACERBATING MPLA SECURITY CONCERNS. THE SOVIETS WOULD ALSO BE ABLE TO PLAY ON THE CONCERNS OF THOSE WITHIN THE PARTY, ESPECIALLY THE PROMINENT MULATTD HARDLINERS AND THOSE BLACKS WHO HAVE BEEN OPENLY ALIGNED WITH THE SOVIETS, FOR WHOM CUBAN WITHDRAWAL COULD SPELL PERSONAL LOSS OF POWER.

12. AS THE MPLA WORKS TO DEVELOP CONCRETE IDEAS ON THE CUBAN WITHDRAWAL QUESTIDN AND ARRIVE AT WHAT WILL BE THE MOST POLITICALLY SENSITIVE DECISION EVER TAKEN BY THE PARTY, DOS SANTOS AND THE REST OF THE MPLA LEADERSHIP WILL NEED ENCOURAGEMENT AND SUPPORT. THE FLS, OUR CG

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

PARTNERS, AND OUR OTHER INFLUENTIAL EUROPEAN ALLIES MUST PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN THIS. YOU SHOULD ALL BE ALERT TO OPPORTUNITIES AND DANGERS AS THE SITUATION UNFOLDS.

13. THE PORTUGUESE HAVE PLAYED A PARTICULARLY HELPFUL ROLE IN URGING THE ANGOLANS TOWARDS FLEXIBILITY ON THE CUBAN WITHDRAWAL QUESTION. A HIGH-LEVEL MISSION SENT TO LUANDA ON THE EVE OF WISNER'S VISIT INFLUENCED THE POSITIVE TONE OF DOS SANTOS' DISCUSSIONS WITH WISNER.

14. THE MPLA HAS NOT BACKED AWAY FROM INFLEXIBILITY ON NATIONAL RECONCILIATION. TACTICALLY, WE ARE CONCENTRATING OUR EFFORTS ON THE CUBAN WITHDRAWAL ISSUE; CUBAN WITHDRAWAL IS CLEARLY A PREREQUISITE FOR RECONCILIATION. RECONCILIATION REMAINS A KEY OBJECTIVE: OUR ASSESSMENT CONTINUES TO BE THAT THE REALITY OF A CONTINUING CIVIL WAR WILL FORCE THE MPLA TO SEEK AN ACCOMMODATION WITH UNITA. WHILE WE DO NOT WANT TO PRESS THE RECONCILIATION THEME AT THIS PARTICULARLY SENSITIVE STAGE OF THE NEGOTIATIONS, WE SHOULD BE PREPARED TO ENCOURAGE AND SUPPORT ANY INITIATIVE WHICH MAY BE LAUNCHED BY OTHER AFRICANS OR THE MPLA ITSELF.



WE BELIEVE THAT STUDY WHICH PYM PROPOSED TO THE SECRETARY AT THEIR JULY 27 MEETING AND WHICH UK POLITICAL DIRECTOR BULLARD MENTIONED TO CHARGE AUGUST 17 (REFTEL) IS POTENTIALLY A VERY USEFUL INITIATIVE. YOU SHOULD INFORM BULLARD THAT OUR REACTION TO THIS PROPOSAL REMAINS POSITIVE AND SUGGEST THAT HE PLAN TO RAISE IT, AS A UK IDEA, AT THE NEXT QUAD POLITICAL DIRECTORS MEETING. WE WOULD BE INTERESTED IN ANY INDICATIONS BRITISH MIGHT HAVE REGARDING LIKELY FRENCH REACTION TO SUCH A PROPOSAL. OUR ASSUMPTION IS THAT THE GERMANS WOULD HAVE NOTHING AGAINST IT AND WE WOULD BE INTERESTED IN WHETHER UK SHARES THIS ASSESSMENT OF THE FRE POSITION.
