Soviet Union. In the wake of the 26th Party Congress, the Soviet Government had launched a full-scale "peace" campaign designed to bring public opinion to bear on President Reagan and other allied leaders to react to Brezhnev's foreign policy proposals:

- Over the weekend, letters were handed to Western heads of state from Ham with Brezhnev; they were essentially identical, restating Brezhnev's Congress speech proposal. There was in them no flexibility on major issues of contention (e.g., Afghanistan), nor any hint of fresh ideas.
- -- Soviet diplomats have been actively soliciting U.S. TV media to carry the Soviet case to the American public: in some cases, their remarks overstepped the limits of proper diplomatic behavior.
- Iurii Arbatov, the principal Soviet expert on America is about to grace our shores: not known for his reticence, he is likely to carry the Brezhnev message from coast to coast. One of his forums will be an International Conference of Physicians for the Prevention of Nuclear Area War, to be held in Washington later in March. (8)

Soviet Arms Sales. Recently obtained figures indicate that Soviet arms sales to less developed countries have almost doubled compared with 1979, attaining an annual figure of \$14 billion. Ninety-five percent of this materiel was sold to three countries: Libya, Algeria and India. Libya, which purchased \$8.0 billion-worth of weaponry, is rapidly turning into the principal Soviet weapon depot serving Africa and the Middle East. It is a country which ought to be closely watched. (S) If will be the fluff.

Poland. After a couple of weeks of relative quiet, Poland is again in the news. There exist solid indications that the Soviet Government is growing inpatient with the inability of the Kania-Jaruzelski Government to deal with Solidarity and is exhorting it to take tougher measures. The detention of several important intellectuals, combined with a bizarre political campaign meant to suggest that Jews are masterminding Polish unrest must be seen as part of this process. The preparations for the UNION-81 military exercises which are to take place from March 17-25 involving Warsaw Pact troops indicate to military analysts that they may be more related to plans for intervention than for maneuvers.
