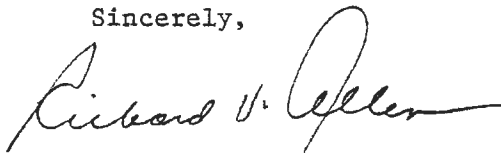
Dear Mr. Mendelevich:
