SUBJECT: Soviet Military Power

Attached is a copy of "Soviet Military Power," the new Defense report on the Soviet military threat. Last spring my NATO colleagues were impressed with our classified briefings on the Russian threat, and asked if we could do an unclassified version for various audiences in their countries.

The report they asked for is now published and is being distributed to the Ministers of Defense and our major allies for their use as desired. It will be made public next Tuesday, 29 September, both here and in Europe.

I have also attached a copy of the letter that I am sending to the Cabinet and senior White House officials.

I hope this factual summary of the magnitude and extent of the Soviet military buildup will increase public awareness of the threat and focus the defense debate on the national security needs of the free world.
