1. FOLLOWING ARE THE PORTIONS OF SECRETARY HAIG'S
BRIEFING OF THE PRESS WHICH DEALT WITH THE LEBANON CRISIS.
BEGIN TEXT:

SECRETARY HAIG: NOW, THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THIS BRIEFING,
OF COURSE, IS TO COVER THE POLITICAL HIGHLIGHTS OF THE
JUST CONCLUDED SUMMIT. BUT I KNOW THAT ALL OF YOU ARE
VERY CONCERNED, AS ARE WE, ABOUT THE WORSENING SITUATION
IN LEBANON, AND I THOUGHT I WOULD SAY A FEW WORDS ABOUT
THAT AT THE OUTSET, AND GET IT BEHIND US, AND TO TAKE CARE
OF YOUR CONCERNS.

WE HAVE BEEN WATCHING THIS SITUATION MOMENT BY MOMENT
AS IT UNFOLDS. THE PRESIDENT HAS FOLLOWED IT THROUGHOUT
THE DAY, AND HAS SHARED WITH HIS COLLEAGUES DURING THE
PLENARY SESSION THE UPDATES THAT WE HAD AS THEY DEVELOPED
TO INCLUDE THE FACT OF HIS COMMUNICATION VERY EARLY THIS
MORNING WITH PRIME MINISTER BEGIN AND THE RESPONSE RE-
CEIVED LATER THIS AFTERNOON FROM MR. BEGIN.

- NOW, THAT RESPONSE WAS CONSISTENT WITH THE DECISION
MADE BY THE ISRAELI CABINET AND ANNOUNCED IN JERUSALEM
WHICH READS AS FOLLOWS: "THE CABINET TOOK THE FOLLOWING
DECISION, FIRST, TO INSTRUCT THE ISRAELI DEFENSE FORCES
TO PLACE ALL CIVILIAN POPULATION OF THE GALILEE BEYOND
THE RANGE OF THE TERRORIST FIRE FROM LEBANON WHERE THEY,

ISRAEL CONTINUES TO ASPIRE TO THE SIGNING OF THE PEACE TREATY WITH AN INDEPENDENT LEBANON, ITS TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY RESERVED."

THAT IS THE BRIEF TEXT, WHICH YOU MAY OR MAY NOT HAVE SEEN FROM ISRAEL.

NOW, WE ARE, OF COURSE, EXTREMELY CONCERNED ABOUT THE ESCALATING CYCLE OF VIOLENCE. THE PRESIDENT, YESTERDAY AFTERNOON, ASKED AMBASSADOR HABIB TO PROCEED HERE POST HASTE. HE MET WITH AMBASSADOR HABIB THIS AFTERNOON, AND DECIDED TO SEND HIM DIRECTLY TO ISRAEL AS HIS PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE TO CONDUCT DISCUSSION ON AN URGENT BASIS WITH PRIME MINISTER BEGIN. THE PRESIDENT ALSO DISPATCHED AN URGENT MESSAGE TO PRIME MINISTER BEGIN, TELLING HIM OF HIS DECISION TO DO SO.

I ANTICIPATE THAT PHIL WILL PROCEED ON TO ROME THIS EVENING, AND, HOPEFULLY, WILL ARRIVE IN ISRAEL EARLY TOMORROW MORNING.

IN THE LAST 48 HOURS AT THE PRESIDENT'S DIRECTION, WE HAVE BEEN ENGAGED IN A INTENSE DEGREE OF DIPLOMATIC ACTIVITY IN THE UNITED NATIONS IN NEW YORK, WHERE WE FIRMLY SUPPORTED THE RESOLUTION URGING AN IMMEDIATE CEASE FIRE. AND AS YOU KNOW, PRESIDENT REAGAN JOINED THIS MORNING WITH THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE SUMMIT IN ISSUING A STATEMENT URGING A RESPONSIVE REACTION TO THE U.N. RESOLUTION.

WE HAVE BEEN IN TOUCH WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF ISRAEL FOR A PROLONGED PERIOD ON THE SITUATION IN LEBANON, ALWAYS URGING RESTRAINT. AND ALWAYS HOPING, AS WE CONTINUE TO HOPE, THAT THE CEASE FIRE CAN, EVEN AT THIS LATE DATE, BE REINSTITUTED. AS OF NOW, WE ARE INFORMED THAT THERE ARE TWO ISRAELI MILITARY COLUMNS THAT CROSSED INTO LEBANON FROM ISRAEL, ONE PROCEEDING ALONG THE COAST ROAD IN THE DIRECTION OF TYRE AND THE OTHER THROUGH THE UPPER GALILEE PANHANDLE. THE PENETRATION IN THE

LATTER CASE HAS BEEN APPROXIMATELY 10 KILOMETERS, IN THE FORMER CASE PERHAPS THREE OR FOUR.

WE ARE EXTREMELY DISTURBED BY THE LOSS OF INNOCENT LIVES IN THIS FIGHTING ON THE ISRAELI-LEBANESE BORDER. IT HAS INVOLVED, AS YOU KNOW, THE EXCHANGE OF ARTILLERY AND ROCKETS FOR A PROLONGED PERIOD PRECEDING THE ISRAELI GROUND PENETRATION.

WE ARE CONCERNED ALSO THAT THE FIGHTING NOT BE EXPANDED INTO A BROADER CONFLICT AND ARE ACUTELY CONSCIOUS OF THE PRESENCE OF SYRIAN FORCES IN FAIRLY CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE EASTERN PENETRATION.

WE WILL DO OUR BEST TO CONVEY TO THE GOVERNMENT OF SYRIA THE STATED INTENTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF ISRAEL NOT TO ENGAGE UNLESS ENGAGED BY SYRIAN FORCES.

NOW, I THINK I'LL TAKE YOUR QUESTIONS ON THAT SUBJECT IN A MOMENT. AND IT IS IMPORTANT THAT, OF COURSE, WE RE-FOCUS OUR ATTENTION TO THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUMMIT, WHAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED HERE IN POLITICAL TERMS.

Q. MR. SECRETARY -- MR. SECRETARY, AS YOU KNOW A PLANE OF AMERICAN MANUFACTURE WAS SHUT DOWN OVER LEBANON AND SOME OF THE TANKS WHICH ARE APPARENTLY NOW IN TYRE ARE ALSO OF AMERICAN MANUFACTURE. FROM THE U.S. POINT OF VIEW, IS THIS A LEGITIMATE USE OF AMERICAN SUPPLIED WEAPONS?

WE HAVE BEEN IN DIRECT TOUCH WITH MR. BEGIN. Q. MR. SECRETARY, THE UNITED STATES ASK ISRAEL -- ISRAEL TO WITHDRAW FROM LEBANON?

SECRETARY HAIG: I BEG YOUR PARDON.

Q. WILL THE UNITED STATES ASK ISRAEL TO WITHDRAW FROM LEBANON?

SECRETARY HAIG: CLEARLY WE HAVE SOUGHT THAT. WE DIDN'T WANT THEM TO GO IN THE FIRST PLACE. WE'VE BEEN VERY, VERY CLEAR ABOUT THAT FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD. AS I SAY, THERE'S NO QUESTION ABOUT -- IF YOU'LL READ THE U.N. RESOLUTION WHICH WE SUPPORTED, IN IT'S PREAMBLE IT TALKS ABOUT THE TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF LEBANON.

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


1. HIGHLIGHTS:

- DUE TO NEWS BLACKOUT, ISRAELI MEDIA RELY ON FOREIGN NEWS AGENCIES FOR STORIES ON THE FIGHTING IN LEBANON. MILITARY CORRESPONDENTS REPORT, HOWEVER, THAT "FIRST DAY OBJECTIVES HAVE BEEN ACHIEVED." MAARIV SPECULATES THAT "PEACE FOR GALILEE" OPERATION MIGHT BE OVER BY TONIGHT.
- HA'ARETZ REPORTS THAT BEGIN PERSONALLY TOOK CARE THAT THE OPERATION'S GOALS REMAIN "LIMITED." ALL MEDIA REPORT ON INTER-PARTY SUPPORT FOR THE OPERATION.
- POLITICAL CORRESPONDENTS SAY THAT BEGIN WILL TODAY TELL AMBASSADOR HABIB ISRAEL WANTS A WORLDWIDE CEASEFIRE AND IRONCLAD GUARANTEES THAT THE TERRORISTS DO NOT RETURN TO THE AREAS EVACUATED BY THE ISRAELI ARMY.
- ALL EDITORIALS SUPPORT THE CABINET'S DECISION TO SEND THE ARMY INTO LEBANON. HA'ARETZ AND YEDYOT COMMENTATORS CALL FOR A "LIMITED" OPERATION, ONE WHICH WILL NOT AFFECT LEBANON'S POLITICAL SYSTEM.
- ISRAEL RADIO REPORTS FROM WASHINGTON THAT WHILE THE U.S. WANTS TO USE DIPLOMACY TO DEFUSE THE SITUATION, THERE ARE SOME "HINTS" FROM THE PRESIDENT'S ENTOURAGE THAT ANTI-ISRAELI SANCTIONS MIGHT BE USED IF ISRAEL

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MESSAGE / ANNOTATION:

DOES NOT GO ALONG WITH AMB. HABIB'S IDEAS. END HIGHLIGHTS.

2. THE SITUATION ON THE SPOT:

A) THE ISRAELI ARMY HAS IMPOSED AN ALMOST TOTAL BLACKOUT ON NEWS FROM THE FRONT, A ROUTINE MEASURE REPORTEDLY USED "TO CONFUSE THE ENEMY." IDF SPOKESMAN DID REVEAL THE TAKING OF BEAUFORT CASTLE AND THE DOWNING OF TWO ISRAELI AIRCRAFT. HE REPORTEDLY ADDED THAT HE HAD "NO CONFIRMATION" ABOUT AN ARTILLERY CLASH WITH THE SYRIANS. THE ISRAELI NEWS MEDIA IS THEREFORE REDUCED TO RELYING ON FOREIGN AGENCY REPORTS.

B) SCREAMING HEADLINES DO ANNOUNCE "FIRST DAY OBJECTIVES ACHIEVED," (HA'ARETZ,) OPERATION GOES "ACCORDING TO PLAN," (MAARIV,) "ISRAELI FORCES ADVANCE 'ON SCHEDULE'," (THE JERUSALEM POST.) MAARIV EVEN REPORTS THAT WHEN PM BEGIN MEETS THIS EVENING WITH AMB. HABIB, "THE IDF WILL, HOPEFULLY, HAVE COMPLETED ITS MISSION IN LEBANON."

C) ISRAEL RADIO REPORTED THIS MORNING THAT GALILEE RESIDENTS HAVE SPENT A QUIET NIGHT. NO INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED, "AND EVERYBODY WOKE UP WITH A SMILE ON THEIR FACE, FEELING CONFIDENT THAT THINGS WILL SOON BE O.K. AGAIN." THAT FEELING WAS STRENGTHENED BY THE NEWS THAT THE BEAUFORT CASTLE, "THE TERROR OF GALILEE," HAS BEEN TAKEN.

D) ISRAEL RADIO REPORTED THIS MORNING THAT "THE ISRAELI ARMY HAS DESTROYED MORE THAN 80 TERRORIST INSTALLATIONS AND MILITARY CAMPS IN LEBANON."

E) POLITICAL WRITERS ARE BUSY ANALYSING YESTERDAY'S CABINET COMMUNIQUE ON THE THREE OBJECTIVES OF THE "PEACE FOR GALILEE" OPERATION, ACCORDING TO HA'ARETZ MILITARY CORR. ZEEV SCHIFF, "IT WAS THE PRIME MINISTER HIMSELF WHO MADE SURE THE OBJECTIVES OF THE OPERATION ARE KEPT TO A MINIMUM." DAVAR FEELS THAT "THE MORE MODERATE WING IN THE CABINET HAS WON" YEDIDOT COMMENTATOR BEN-PORAT, WHO FEARS LIKE MANY OTHERS THAT THE SITUATION MIGHT GET OUT OF HAND, DUE MAINLY TO THE "SINGLE MOST SERIOUS IMPONDERABLE - THE SYRIANS," IS A LITTLE UPSET BY THE SECTION IN THE CABINET COMMUNIQUE SPEAKING ABOUT ISRAEL'S DESIRE "TO SIGN A PEACE TREATY WITH INDEPENDENT LEBANON."
