- 1. ALL MAJOR PAPERS CARRY EXTENSIVE FRONTPAGE COVERAGE OF THE ISRAELI INVASION. COMMENTARY AT THIS POINT IS LIMITED BUT SOME THEMES ARE BEGINNING TO EMERGE.
