SUBJECT: AUSTRIAN LEADERS CRITICIZE ISRAELI ACTION IN  
- LEBANON

1. ACCORDING TO AUSTRIAN PRESS REPORTS OF JUNE 8-9, LEADERS OF BOTH THE GOVERNING SOCIALIST PARTY AND THE OPPOSITION PEOPLE'S PARTY IN VIENNA HAVE CRITICIZED THE ISRAELI MILITARY OPERATION IN LEBANON AS A VIOLATION OF INTERNATIONAL LAW. ISRAELI REPRESENTATIVES IN VIENNA HAVE ASKED FOR UNDERSTANDING FOR THE NECESSITY TO WIPE OUT TERRORIST BASES.
2. CHANCELLOR BRUND KREISKY TOLD REPORTERS JUNE 8 AFTER THE WEEKLY CABINET MEETING THAT ISRAEL'S MILITARY ACTION IN SOUTHERN LEBANON WAS "A FRIGHTFUL ACT OF AGGRESSION WITH UNFORESEEABLE CONSEQUENCES." HIS ENTIRE MIDDLE EASTERN POLICY FOR WHICH HE EARNED SO MUCH CRITICISM HAD BEEN BASED ON HIS VERY FEAR OF SUCH A DEVELOPMENT, KREISKY DECLARED, PREDICTING THAT IN THE UNITED NATIONS AUSTRIA WOULD SIDE WITH THOSE CONDEMNING ISRAEL. SIMILARLY, THE SOCIETY FOR AUSTRIAN-ARAB RELATIONS HEADED BY KARL BLECHA, DEPUTY NATIONAL CHAIRMAN OF THE SOCIALIST PARTY, DENOUNCED THE ISRAELI OPERATION AS A VIOLATION OF INTERNATIONAL LAW AND "BLOODY AGGRESSION" AND ASSURED THE LEBANESE AMBASSADOR IN VIENNA OF SOLIDARITY WITH THE VICTIMS OF AGGRESSION.
3. ALDOIS MOCK, NATIONAL CHAIRMAN OF THE PEOPLE'S PARTY, ALSO TERMED THE ISRAELI ACTION A VIOLATION OF INTERNATIONAL LAW. AT THE SAME TIME, MOCK INTRODUCED A

DOMEST C POLITICAL NOTE BY TELLING A PRESS CONFERENCE THAT THE WEAKNESS OF THE UNITED NATIONS DEMONSTRATED IN THE RECENT HOSTILITIES SHOWED HOW IMPORTANT IT WAS FOR EVERY COUNTRY TO HAVE A RELIABLE FOREIGN POLICY AND INTERNAL STABILITY.

AN ADVERTISEMENT PLACED IN THE VIENNA DAILY, KURIER, BY "THE ISRAELIS LIVING IN AUSTRIA" ELABORATED ON THE AMBASSADOR'S REMARKS BY SAYING THAT RADICAL GROUPS, NOTABLY THE PLO, AIMED AT DESTROYING ISRAEL AND ITS POPULATION AND WERE WILDLY USING ALL MEANS, AS COULD BE SEEN FROM THE ASSAULT ON THE ISRAELI AMBASSADOR IN LONDON. "IN ORDER TO FORESTALL FURTHER ASSAULTS CLAIMING INNOCENT LIVES, ISRAEL IS FORCED TO DESTROY TERRORIST BASES IN LEBANON -- FOR ITS OWN PROTECTION AND FOR THE PROTECTION OF ALL PEACE-LOVING PEOPLE ON EARTH," THE ADVERTISEMENT SAID, ASKING FOR UNDERSTANDING OF THE ISRAELI ACTION WHICH AIMED ONLY AT SECURING "A LITTLE PEACE." POLANSKY

MUBARAK AALEGELY STRESSED TO REPORTERS THAT EGYPT WAS ONE OF FIRST COUNTRIES TO DECLARE ITS OPPOSITION TO THE ISRAELI AGGRESSION AND TO CALL FOR WITHDRAWAL. AMB. ATHERTON IS ALSO QUOTED AS TELLING NEWSMEN YESTERDAY THAT EGYPT'S REQUEST FOR U.S. INTERVENTION IN THE CRISIS IS A "POSITIVE ELEMENT" AND THAT U.S. VOTE FOR TWO UNSC CLAUSES IN RESOLUTION AS WELL AS DISPATCH OF AMB. HABIB TO AREA REFLECTS AMERICAN DETERMINATION TO RESOLVE THE SITUATION. (THE NEWS OF THE U.S. VETO OF THE LATEST UNSC RESOLUTION CAME TOO LATE FOR INCLUSION IN THE JUNE 9 NEWSPAPERS.)

--WHEN ASKED BY REPORTERS HOW LEBANESE SITUATION IMPACTS ON HIS DECISION NOT TO ATTEND A SUMMIT MEETING WITH BEGIN, MUBARAK RESPONDED THAT HIS DECISION NOT TO ATTEND A SUMMIT NOW IS BASED ON HIS BELIEF THAT MORE SPADEWORK NEEDS BE DONE PRIOR TO SUCH A MEETING. THE PRESS QUOTES MUBARAK AS SAYING: "IF THE MATTER IS ONLY ONE OF GOING TO AMERICA AND COMING BACK, I CAN VISIT THE U.S. ANY TIME; BUT IF THE PURPOSE IS TO ACHIEVE RESULTS, PREPARATIONS MUST BE MADE."

--ACCORDING TO PRESS, MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS BOUTROS GHALI MET YESTERDAY WITH EAST EUROPEAN AND ASIAN AMBASSADORS TO ENCOURAGE DIPLOMATIC INITIATIVES TO BRING AN END TO CONFLICT. REPORTEDLY HE ALSO RESPONDED TO AN OPPOSITION CALL IN PEOPLES ASSEMBLY FOR A "FREEZE" IN EGYPTIAN-ISRAELI RELATIONS, SAYING THAT THIS IS "NOT IN EGYPT'S INTEREST."

--MORE LOCAL REACTION BEING REPORTED SEPTEL.

2. MOROCCO: MOROCCAN FOMIN BOUCETTA'S VISIT TO EGYPT ALSO RECEIVES PROMINENT COVERAGE IN TODAY'S PRESS. MUBARAK BRIEFED NEWSMEN THAT HE HAD RECEIVED AN ORAL MESSAGE FROM KING HASSAN II AND THAT HIS TALK WITH BOUCETTA HAD CENTERED ON THE CURRENT OAU SITUATION AND THE NON-ALIGNED MOVEMENT. MENA QUOTES MUBARAK AS SAYING THAT ANY DISCUSSION ABOUT RENEWED EGYPT-MOROCCO RELATIONS IS PREMATURE AND THAT IT IS UP TO EACH ARAB NATION TO DECIDE FOR ITSELF THE PROPITIOUS MOMENT TO REESTABLISH RELATIONS WITH EGYPT. BOUCETTA REPORTEDLY HAD EARLIER TERMED DISCUSSIONS WITH MUBARAK AS "QUITE GOOD, FRUITFUL AND VERY POSITIVE." BOUCETTA RETURNED TO RABAT YESTERDAY (SEPTEL).
