Draft Presidential Letter on Persian Gulf

Attached are draft letters prepared respectively by the National Security Council staff and by the Department of Defense in response to the discussion at the PRG meeting chaired by Colin Powell last week concerning the Persian Gulf. The original purpose of this draft was to reconcile in concise and elementary form the respective risk estimates prepared and circulated by the Central Intelligence Agency and the Department of Defense and to formally articulate the Administration's view that U.S. forces are not being introduced in a situation involving the imminent threat of hostilities.

As you know, much has happened since the PRG meeting and such a letter perhaps has been overtaken by events. On the other hand, I think it appropriate to utilize the letter as a basis for discussion.

I look forward to sceing you at the meeting scheduled on Friday, June 26, 1987, at 4:30 p.m. in the Situation Room at the White House.
