1. THE FOLLOWING ARTICLE BY ISRAEL AMRANI ON THE LEGAL PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PRISONERS TAKEN IN THE IDF'S LEBANUM OPERATION APPEARED IN THE JUNE 16 JERUSALEM POST.

2. COMMENCE TEXT:
AN ESTIMATED 6,000 PLD SUSPECTS, CAPTURED IN LEBANON
DURING THE CAMPAIGN, PRESENT AN IMMENSE LEGAL
PROBLEM FOR ISRAEL, LEGAL EXPERTS IN JERUSALEM
SAID YESTERDAY.

JUSTICE MINISTER MOSHE NISSIM HAS APPOINTED JUDGE ZVI TERLO, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL LABOR COURT AND JUDGE HAIM PIZAM OF THE HAIFA DISTRICT COURT TO HEAD TWO SPECIAL TRIBUNALS TO DEAL WITH THE QUESTION.

AMONG THE PROBLEMS TO BE SURTED OUT BY THE TRIBUNALS IS THE OUFSTION OF THE FUREIGN NATIONALS AMONG THE PRISONERS, INCLUDING CITIZENS OF NON-ARAB COUNTRIES. HANY PRISONERS ARE UNDER AGE, AND ALL OF THEM, IF BROUGHT TO TRIAL, ARE ENTITLED TO STATE-PROVIDED LEGAL COUNSEL.

THE MAIN PROBLEM CONCERNS THE STATUS OF THE PRISONERS. ISRAEL IS A SIGNATURY OF THE 1947 GENEVA CUNVENTION, WHICH DEFINES A PRISONER-OF-WAR AS SOMEONE SERVING IN THE ARMY OF A RECOGNIZED STATE. A POW ENJOYS PRIVILEGES, SUCH AS VISITS FROM THE INTERNATIONAL RED CROSS AND MAY NOT BE PUT ON TRIAL. ISRAEL DUES NOT RECOGNIZE THE PLU AND HAS, IN THE PAST, PROSECUTED ANYONE SUSPECTED OF BELONGING TO IT AS BEING MEMBERS OF A "HUSTILE ORGANIZATION." JUST OVER 3,000 CONVICTED TERRORISTS ARE CURRENTLY IN ISRAELI PRISONS, ALMOST ALL OF THEM TRIED WITHIN THE LAST 15 YEARS. THE ENTIRE PRISON POPULATION OF ISRAEL IS ABOUT 6.500. ALREADY IN VERY CRAMPED CONDITIONS. TO COMPLICATE MATTERS, THE PLO IS BELIEVED TO HOLD ABOUT 10 ISRAELI SOLDIERS AS CAPTIVES. THE PLO ANNOUNCED LAST WEEK, FOLLOWING THE CAPTURE OF AN ISRAELI PILOT, THAT IT WOULD TREAT ALL ISRAELI SULDIERS IT HOLDS AS POWS. FOLLOWING THE LITANI OPERATION IN 1978, ISRAEL RELEASED 76 CONVICTED TERRORISTS IN EXCHANGE FOR ONE ISRAELI SOLDIER, CAPTURED BY THE PLO. THE SOLDIER, AVRAHAM AMRAN, WAS GIVEN POW STATUS BY THE PLU, AND WAS ALLOWED VISITS BY THE INTERNATIONAL RED CRUSS.

LEGALLY SPEAKING, THE 6,000 NEW PRISUNERS ARE CONSIDERED "ADMINISTRATIVE DETAINEES," BY THE JUSTICE MINISTRY. THE 1948 EMERGENCY DRDINANCES ALLOW THE CHIEF OF STAFF TO RENEW THEIR DETENTION EVERY THREE MONTHS. BUT THEY WILL HAVE TO STAND TRIAL ULTIMATELY. ACCORDING TO PROFESSOR CLAUDE KLEIN, DEAN OF THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY FACULTY OF LAW, TRYING ALL CAPTIVES IS ALL BUT AN IMPOSSIBLE TASK. MOREOVER, IF ISRAFL DOES NOT RECOGNIZE THEM AS POWS, THE PLU MIGHT RETALIATE BY NOT GIVING THIS STATUS TO IDE CAPTIVES. "WE CAN'T DEMAND THAT THE PLU TREAT OUR PRISONERS BETTER THAN WE TREAT THEIRS," HE SAID. A WAY DUT, SAYS KLEIN, IS TO RECOGNIZE THEM AS POWS, DESPITE PAST POLICY. UNTIL NOW MOST TERRORISTS WORE NO UNIFORM, AND DID NOT BELONG TO A REGULAR FORCE. THE NEW PRISONERS MOSTLY WURE UNIFORMS AND BELONGED TO A MORE-OR-LESS

BEEN BETTER ID POSTPUNE THIS TRIP TO THE UNITED STATES? (ANSWER) NO, IT DID NOT EVEN UCCUR 10 ME TO PUST-PONE MY VISIT. I WAS INVITED TO SPEAK BEFORE THE UN ASSEMBLY ABOUT DISARMAMENT AND INTERNATIONAL PEACE, AND I THINK THAT THIS IS A VERY GOOD TIME FOR THE PRIME MINISTER OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL TO APPEAR WITH SUCH A SPEECH BEFURE THE UN MEMBERS. MOREUVER, THE U.S. PRESIDENT, WHO FROM THE START INTENDED TO SEE ME IN NEW YORK SINCE HE TOU WILL BE SPEAKING BEFURE THE UN ASSEMBLY, THE DAY BEFORE, CHANGED HIS MIND, AND HE INVITED ME TO SEE HIM NEXT MUNDAY, THAT IS TO SAY UN THE 21ST UF JUNE IN WASHINGTON. HE SET ASIDE A LONG TIME FOR THE TALK WITH HE, ABOUT 4 HOURS. WE HAVE MANY TUPICS TO DISCUSS. THIS IS A GUOD AND IMPORTANT OPPORTUNITY BOTH FUR THE PRESIDENT AND FOR ME, FROM THE VIEWPOINT OF BILATERAL RELATIONS BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND ISRAEL, FROM THE VIEWPOINT OF INTERNATIONAL PULICIES BETWEEN THE FREE WORLD AND THE TOTALITARIAN WORLD, AND FROM THE VIEWPOINT OF THE MIDDLE EAST, AN OPPORTUNITY TO HAVE A VERY SERIOUS CLARIFYING DISCUSSION. I WILL ALSO MEET WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE, WHO INFORMED ME THAT HE WILL COME TO MEET ME UN FRIDAY. WE WILL HAVE BREAKFAST TUGETHER AND HE WILL MATURALLY TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE UPPORTUNITY TO DISCUSS PRUBLEMS BEFORE I GO TO THE UNITED NATIONS.

HENCE, THIS IS A VISIT OF NATIONAL IMPURTANCE, AND THERE WAS NO REASON, I SEE NU REASON TO POSTPONE AS TO THE SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY, THERE IS NOW A CFASE-FIRE, THE POLITICAL CAMPAIGN HAS BEGUN; MY COLLEAGUES IN THE GOVERNMENT HEADED BY DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER MR. EHRLICH, THE FOREIGN MINISTER, THE DEFENSE MINISTER AND ALL THE CABINET MEMBERS ARE VERY FAMILIAR WITH THE PROBLEMS SINCE DURING THE CAMPAIGN WE HAD CABINET MEETINGS ALMOST EVERY DAY. ALL THE CABINET MEMBERS ARE FAMILIAR WITH THE PROBLEM, AND I DO NOT DOUBT THAT THEY WILL MANAGE THINGS PROPERLY AND FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE. (QUESTIAN) MR.
