2. COMMENCE TEXT. TITLE -- BEGIN SAID: "I'LL NOT ABANDON MAJOR HADDAD" WHEN HABIB PRESENTED HIS "FOUR-

POINT PLAN" FOR LEBANON
"GEN. (DAVID) JONES, THE AMERICAN CHIEF OF STAFF, HAS
SOUNDED A VERY INTERESTING WARNING...," SAID THE
PRIME MINSITER, MENAHEM BEGIN, TO PRESIDENT REAGAN'S
ENVOY, PHILIP HABIB. "HE STATED THAT PEACE MUST BE
INSTALLED IN LEBANON, BUT HE STATED MORE THAN THAT:
ALL FOREIGN ARMED FORCES; NAMELY, THE SYRIANS, THE ISRAELIS

AND THE PALESTINIAN TERRORISTS, MUST GET OUT OF LEBANDN."

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MESSAGE / ANNOTATION:

"I CAN ASSURE YOU," HABIB RESPONDED WITHOUT HESTIATION, "THAT WE SHALL NOT GO BACK ON THIS WA D . 11 IN THIS MANNER DID PHILIP HABIB TAKE LEAVE OF BEGIN WHEN HE, REGIN, LEFT THE THE U.S.A. ON THE MOKROW, THE ISRAELI AMBASSADOR IN THE U.S.A., MOSHE ARENS, REPORTED TO THE PRIME MINISTER ON A CONVERSATION HE HAD HAD WITH THE AMERICAN SECRETARY OF STATE, ALEXANDER HAIG, AND IN THIS CONVERSATION HAIG DID NOT CONCEAL HIS DELIGHT AT THE DRAMATIC DEVELOPMENTS THAT HAD OCCURRED IN LEBANDN IN THE SPAN OF DNE AND AS TO THE PERMANENT SETTLEMENT WHICH THE U.S.A. AND ISRAEL ARE JOINTLY STRIVING TO BRING ABOUT IN LEBANUN, HAIG EXPRESSED THE VIEW THAT "THE PROSPECTS ARE BRIGHT." SEVENTY-TWO HOURS BEFORE BEGIN'S MEETING WITH REAGAN, THERE IS NOBODY HERE WHO CAN POINT TO A WATERED-DOWN AMERICAN PLAN FOR A SETTLEMENT IN LEBANON. THIS MUCH CAN BE SAID, THAT IN THE FREQUENT CONTACTS BEHIND THE SCENES, IT HAS TRANSPIRED BEYOND ALL DOUBT

THAT THERE IS A LARGER DEGREE OF AGREEMENT THAN DISSENT.

AT LAST SUNDAY'S CABINET MEETING, SOME MINISTERS THOUGHT ALOUD THAT THIS WAS NOT THE PROPER TIME FOR A TRIP TO THE U.S.A. BEGIN'S REASONING WAS: "WHY SHOULDN'T I MAKE THE TRIP? ... I'LL EXPLAIN TO THE PRESIDENT THAT WE HAVE NOTHING TO FEAR." MAYRE THOSE MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNMENT WHO COUNSELED BEGIN NOT TO GO WERE AFRAID OF THE MEETING BETWEEN HIM AND THE U.S. PRESIDENT, WHU A FEW DAYS EARLIER HAD NOT HESITATED TO SEND THE PRIME MINISTER A VIGOROUS NOTE, WHICH FOR SHEER VIGOR HAS NOT HAD ITS LIKES EVER SINCE THE TWO LEADERS HAVE EXCHANGED NOTES --AND THEIR NUMBER RUNS INTO DUZENS. THUS, FOR EXAMPLE, REAGAN STATED THAT IF ISRAEL DID NOT AGREE TO A CEASEFIRE, THIS WOULD CREATE "PROFOUND TENSION" IN OUR RELATIONS. THAT WAS ON HE THURSDAY OF LAST WEEK. THE FOLLOWING DAY ISRAEL CEASED FIRE IN LEBANON UNILATERALLY, AND SINCE THEN, SO IT WOULD SEEM, UNDERSTANDING HAS BEEN RESTORED BETWEEN WASHINGTON AND JERUSALEM. WHAT DID ISRAEL WANT? ISRAEL WANTED ABOVE ALL TWO THINGS: THAT A MULTINATIONAL FORCE, AND NOT A UN FORCE, BE STATIONED ON THE 45 KM SECURITY LINE, AND THAT ALL FOREIGN ARMED FORCES; I.E., SYRIA AND THE TERRORISTS, BE WITHDRAWN FROM LEBANON

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(ISRAEL'S DWN READINESS TO WITHDRAW WAS ANNOUNCED ON THE DAY WHEN THE "PEACE FOR GALILEE" CAMPAIGN WAS BT #9245 NNNN

TO TRY AND ENCOURAGE PRESIDENT SARKIS TO SET UP A CENTRAL AUTHORITY AS THE FOUNDATION OF THE NEW STRUCTURE. PHILIP HABIB EXPLAINS THAT IN HIS CONVERSATION WITH SARKIS HE WILL PROBE WHETHER HE, SARKIS, IS ABLE TO HELP INSTALL SUCH A "CENTRAL AUTHORITY," DR IN OTHER WORDS WHETHER HIS GOVERNMENT WILL BE ABLE TO ACCOMPLISH THIS TASK. AND THE MAN WHO CHARGED HABIB WITH THIS MISSION WAS ALEXANDER HAIG. SO WHEN BEGIN LEFT FOR THE U.S.A. TO MEET WITH PRESIDENT REAGAN, HE DID NOT SET FURTH ON A COURSE STREWN WITH UNKNOWNS. AT LEAST HALF OF THE WORK HAD BEEN DONE. AT FIRST IT LOOKED AS IF UNDERSTANDING WAS LACKING BETWEEN BEGIN AND HAIG. SUDDENLY THE PRIME MINISTER GETS A CABLE FRUM AMBASSADOR ARENS, WHICH MADE STUNNING READING, TO THE EFFECT THAT HAIG ATTRIBUTES TO HIM THE INTENTION OF STAYING IN LEBANON FIVE YEARS. WHAT? WHENEVER DID I SAY ANYTHING OF THE KIND? THE

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PRIME MINISTER FUMED. FROM WHOM COULD HAIG HAVE HEARD SUCH A THING? FROM NO DIE BUT HABIB SO AT HIS NEETING WITH HIM ON JUNE 14, BEGIN DID NOT HESITATE TO TAKE THE MATTER UP WITH THE AUTHOR IN PERSON: BY THE WAY, DO PLEASE TELL ME, MR. HABIB, WHENEVER DID I SAY THAT IT WAS OUR INTENTION TO STAY IN LEBANON FIVE YEARS? NO, THERE HAS BEEN A MISUNDERSTANDING HERE -- HABIB REPLIED APOLOGETICALLY -- I UNLY REPORTED THAT YOU HAD SAID ... WHAT I SAID -- BEGIN RESTATED EMPHATICALLY -- WAS THAT WE ARE READY TO LEAVE LEBANON EVEN WITHIN WEEKS, IF, OF COURSE, A SUITABLE AGREEMENT IS REACHED. BUT IF SUCH AN AGREEMENT IS NOT REACHED, THEN WE SHALL BE READY TO STAY IN LEBANON AS LONG AS MAY BE NECESSARY, EVEN IF IT TAKES FIVE YEARS.

THE MISUNDERSTANDING WAS CLEARED UP. NOW HABIB AND HAIG, AND SURELY ALSO THE PRESIDENT, UNDERSTAND THAT UNLY A "FIT AGREEMENT," AS BEGIN TERMED IT, WILL GET ISRAEL OUT OF LEBANON. AND, IN EFFECT, HABIB -- IN ACCORD WITH HIS PRINCIPALS -- HAS PUT FORWARD A SCHEME FOR JUST SUCH AN AGREEMENT THAT HAD BEEN RIPENING IN THE MINDS OF THE ADMINISTRATION IN WASHINGTON. PRIOR TO BEGIN'S DEPARTURE FOR THE U.S.A., HABIB PRESENTED A SORT OF "FOUR-POINT PLAN" FOR A SETTLEMENT IN LEBANON, AND SAID PLAINLY: IT IS SECRETARY OF STATE HAIG WHO HAS ASKED ME TO PUT TO YOU WHAT WE SEE AS FOUR BASIC AIMS:

- -- STRENGTHENING THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT IN LEBANON.
- -- A "DRAMATIC REDUCTION" OF THE SYRIAN FORCES IN LEBANDN.
- IN LEBANON. THE PALESTINIANS MUST BE KEPT WITHIN A FRAMEWORK WHICH IN PRACTICE WILL PERMIT THE CENTRAL AUTHORITY TO BE IN THE HANDS OF THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT, AS WAS THE CASE BEFORE THE PLO ESTABLISHED ITS MASSIVE INFRASTRUCTURE (WHICH HAS BEEN DESTRUYED BY ISRAEL).

THIS, THEREFORE, IS TO BE THE AMERICAN PLAN FOR A PERMANENT SETTLEMENT IN LEBANON, ALONG WITH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MULTINATIONAL FORCE THAT WILL ENSURE THE WITHDRANAL OF ISRAEL AND THE DEMILITARIZATION OF THE 40 KM AREA (ISRAEL CLAIMS THAT, ACTUALLY, THE BOUNDARY LINE SHOULD BE SET AT BETWEEN 43 AND 48 KM), WHAT DOES ISRAEL HAVE TO SAY ABOUT THIS?

FIRST THREE PRINCIPLES, SUBJECT TO A BALANCE BEING ESTABLISHED BETWEEN SYRIA AND ISRAEL: WHY DU YOU

SPEAK OF A "DRAMATIC REDUCTION" OF THE SYRIAN FORCES,

BEGIN ASKED HABIB, WHEREAS YOU EXPECT ISRAEL SIMPLY

TO WITHDRAW "IN DRAMATIC FASHION"? ...

"NO," HABIB REASSURED BEGIN, "WE DO NOT MEAN TO SAY ANYTHING DIFFERENT FROM WHAT SECRETARY OF STATE HAIG

SAID IN ANOTHER CONTEXT, THAT HE WILL ACT TO GET

ALL FOREIGN ELEMENTS DUT DE LEBANDN."

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AND THERE THE TWO, BEGIN AND HABIB, REACHED THE MAIN POINT OF DIVERGENCE: THE STATUS OF MAJ. HADDAD AND THE "DOMINION" HE GOVERNS.
HABIB WAS ALREADY PREPARED TO "RUSH" HIS PLAN TO SARKIS, BUT BEGIN STOPPED HIM: JUST A MOMENT, MR. HABIB, WHAT YOU SPEAK OF IN POINT FOUR (CONCERNING HADDAD) IS NOT AN "ENCLAVE"...IT IS HADDAD'S REGION. ON THIS SCORE BEGIN WAS EMPHATIC.

HABIB -- THAT IS, THE U.S. ADMINISTRATION -- WHO BEGAN DUTLINING THE NEW SETTLEMENT WHILE THE GUNS WERE STILL THUNDERING IN LEBANON, IS INSISTENT: WE DEFINITELY INTEND TO LIQUIDATE HADDAD'S ENCLAVE AND HIS INDEPENDENT STATUS.... HADDAD AND HIS MEN HAVE TO BE INTEGRATED IN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AGREEMENT WHICH WILL EMBRACE ALL THE POLITICAL FACTORS IN LEBANON AND WHICH WILL STRENGTHEN THE STANDING OF THE LEGITIMATE GOVERNMENT IN LEBANDN. NO -- BEGIN RULED STRONGLY -- AS REGARDS HADDAD, I AM NOT PREPARED TO ACCEPT A SINGLE WORD OF THE TEXT PUT BEFORE ME. THAT'S A VERY SPECIAL PROBLEM, ON WHICH THE ISRAEL GOVERNMENT WILL HAVE TO STATE ITS POSITION, AND I CAN TELL YOU HERE AND NOW THAT IF YOU EXPECT US TO ABANDON HADDAD, TAKE NOTE OF THE FACT THAT WE DO NOT ABANDON FRIENDS AND THEREFORE WE SHALL NOT TURN DUR BACK ON HADDAD. WE'LL NEVER DU THAT. LET US THEREFORE AGREE, BEGIN WENT ON, THAT WHAT YOU HAVE PROPOSED, MR. HABIB, IS A "UNILATERAL DECLARATION" OF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT, AND THAT ISRAEL WILL PRESENT A SPECIFIC AND DETAILED PROPOSAL OF ITS OWN IN THIS MATTER. PHILIP HABIR AGAIN TRIED TO SOFTEN BEGIN'S APPROACH, QUERYING: ISN'T IT SELF-UNDERSTOOD THAT THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT IN LEBANON MUST EXTEND ITS AUTHORITY TO ALL PARTS OF LEBANDN? ... WHAT YOU SAY IS NOT AT ALL ACCEPTABLE TO ISRAEL. AND PERHAPS YOU WILL PERMIT ME TO PUT IN A FURTHER WORD. YOU HAVE RAISED THE IDEA, MR. HABIB, OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT GRANTING AN "AMNESTY" TO MAJ. HADDAD AND HIS EN. IT SEEMS TO ME THAT THIS CONCEPT OF AN "AMNESTY" IN THE CASE WE ARE DEALING WITH IS SIMPLY AN INSULT....

BEGIN BELIEVES THERE IS NO CONTRADICTION BETWEEN HIS SUPPORT FOR THE IDEA OF STRENGTHENING THE STANDING OF THE GOVERNMENT IN LEBANON (HE ADVISED HABIB TO URGE SARKIS TO HAVE ALL FOREIGN FORCES EVACUATED FROM

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LEBANON) AND HIS OWN CONCEPT OF THE SPECIAL STATUS
