THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL MEETS AT A TIME WHEN A VERY SERIOUS AND DANGEROUS CRISIS IN THE MIDDLE EAST THREATENS WORLD PEACE AND STABILITY AND THE GAINS ACQUIRED BY THE RELENTLESS EFFORTS EXERTED THROUGH THE PAST FIVE YEARS IN ORDER TO ATTAIN A JUST AND COMPREHENSIVE PEACE IN THE AREA, PRESIDENT MUBARAK WOULD LIKE TO SEND A MESSAGE OF FRIEND-

FURTHERMORE ISRAEL IS GETTING READY TO LAUNCH AN ALL-OUT ATTACK AGAINST THE CITY OF BEIRUT AND ENSURE THE PHYSICAL LIQUIDATION OF THE PALESTINIAN LEADERS. EGYPT HAS CONDEMNED THE ISRAELI ACTION AS ILLEGAL, INHUMAN AND CONTRARY TO THE SPIRIT OF THE CAMP DAVID ACCORDS IN THAT IT VIOLATES THE PRINCIPLE OF SOLVING ALL DISPUTES BY PEACEFUL MEANS.

THE EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT HAS SPARED NO EFFORTS IN ITS CONTACTS WITH PALESTINIANS TO PERSUADE THEM TO BE RESPONSIVE AND COOPERATIVE.

BUT ISRAEL MUST BE MADE TO UNDERSTAND THAT THE INTEREST OF PEACE AS WELL AS ITS OWN INTEREST REQUIRE A MORE FLEXIBLE ATTITUDE AND RESPECT OF THE NORMS OF INTERNATIONAL BEHAVIOR.

THE USE OF THE VETO BY THE UNITED STATES IN THE SECURITY COUNCIL WAS DISCOURAGING AND DISAPPOINTING. IT PROVED THAT ALTHOUGH THE UNITED STATES HAS ACCEPTED TO PLAY THE ROLE OF FULL PARTNER IN THE PEACE PROCESS, IT IS NOT YET WILLING TO ADOPT THE POLICY THAT WOULD BE CONSISTENT WITH THIS ROLE. LACK OF FIRMNESS ON THE PART OF THE UNITED STATES GIVES ISRAEL THE IMPRESSION THAT IT CAN COUNT ON AN AMERICAN BACKING REGARDLESS OF ITS POLICY TOWARD THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE.

IN THIS FRAMEWORK THE EUROPEAN COUNTRIES CAN AND SHOULD PLAY AN IMPORTANT PART TO ENSURE THAT THE AGGRESSION WOULD NOT BE REWARDED, THAT THE INDEPENDENCE OF LEBANON, ITS TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY AND SOVEREIGNTY WOULD BE RESPECTED AND THAT A JUST POLITICAL SOLUTION SHOULD BE SOUGHT TO THE PALESTINIAN PROBLEM INSTEAD OF THE ATTEMPT TO ANNIHILATE THE PALESTINIAN LEADERSHIP.

THE CALL FOR A CEASE-FIRE AND THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES FROM LEBANON MEANS THAT AMERICA IS NOT ASKING ISRAEL TO WITHDRAW FROM LEBANON UNLESS THE OTHER FORCES--THAT IS OF COURSE, THE PALESTINIAN AND SYRIAN DETERRENT FORCES--ALSO WITHDRAW."

1. SUMMARY: EC COMMISSION IS INTERESTED IN PROVIDING ADDITIONAL HUMANITARIAN AID TO LEBANON. HOWEVER, IT DOES NOT WANT TO DUPLICATE U.S. EFFORTS AND OFFICIALS HAVE REQUESTED INFORMATION ON KINDS OF U.S. AID, DISTRIBUTION CHANNELS AND POPULATION TO WHICH IT IS DESTINED. END SUMMARY.

2. REFS B AND C GIVE RUN-DOWN ON EC EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR LEBANON WHICH NOW TOTALS 700,000 ECU (1 ECU EQUALS \$,95) TO BE CHanneled THROUGH THE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE OF THE RED CROSS. EARLY MEMBER STATE APPROVAL IS EXPECTED OF 50 MILLION ECUS IN SPECIAL EUROPEAN INVESTMENT BANK LOANS FOR REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION. IN ADDITION, THE COMMISSION HAS DECIDED TO ALLOCATE 10,000 ADDITIONAL TONS OF CEREALS AS EMERGENCY FOOD AID ABOVE THE NORMAL 1982 ALLOCATION FOR LEBANON OF 10,000.

3. IN RECENT CONVERSATIONS, BOTH EC FOOD AID AND EMERGENCY AID OFFICIALS HAVE EXPRESSED COMMISSION'S DESIRE TO
