THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL MEETS AT A TIME WHEN A VERY SERIOUS AND DANGEROUS CRISIS IN THE MIDDLE EAST THREATENS WORLD PEACE AND STABILITY AND THE GAINS ACQUIRED BY THE RELENT-LESS EFFORTS EXERTED THROUGH THE PAST FIVE YEARS IN ORDER TO ATTAIN A JUST AND COMPREHENSIVE PEACE IN THE AREA, PRESIDENT MUBARAK WOULD LIKE TO SEND A MESSAGE OF FRIEND-

SHIP TO THE EUROPEAN HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT AND TO EXPRESS EGYPT'S APPRECIATION FOR THE CONCERN SHOWN BY THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY TOWARD THE SITUATION IN LEBANG RESULT-ING FROM ISRAELI MILITARY AGGRESSION AGAINST LEBANON. AFTER ALMOST 22 DAYS SINCE THE ISRAELI INVASION OF LEBANON THE SITUATION IS DETERIORATING AT A VERY DANGEROUS PACE, THE ISRAELI FORCES ARE STILL OCCUPYING MORE THAN A THIRD OF LEBANON, THOUSANDS OF CIVILIAN PALESTINIANS AS WELL AS LEBANESE HAVE BEEN KILLED AND OTHERS ARE STILL FACING THE HORRORS AND THE IMPACT OF ISRAELI ADVANCED MILITARY TECHNOLOGY. FURTHERMORE ISRAEL IS GETTING READY TO LAUNCH AN ALL-OUT ATTACK AGAINST THE CITY OF BEIRUT AND ENSURE THE PHYSICAL LIQUIDATION OF THE PALESTINIAN LEADERS. EGYPT HAS CONDEMNED THE ISRAELI ACTION AS ILLEGAL, INHUMAN AND CONTRARY TO THE SPIRIT OF THE CAMP DAVID ACCORDS IN THAT IT VIOLATES THE PRINCIPLE OF SOLVING ALL DISPUTES BY PEACEFUL MEANS. THE EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT HAS SPARED NO EFFORTS IN ITS CONTACTS WITH PALESTINIANS TO PERSUADE THEM TO BE RESPONSIVE AND COOPERATIVE. BUT ISRAEL MUST BE MADE TO UNDERSTAND THAT THE INTEREST OF PEACE AS WELL AS ITS OWN INTEREST REQUIRE A MORE FLEXIBLE ATTITUDE AND RESPECT OF THE NORMS OF INTERNATIONAL BEHAVIOR.

THE USE OF THE VETO BY THE UNITED STATES IN THE SECURITY COUNCIL WAS DISCOURAGING AND DISAPPOINTING. IT PROVED THAT ALTHOUGH THE UNITED STATES HAS ACCEPTED TO PLAY THE ROLE OF FULL PARTNER IN THE PEACE PROCESS, IT IS NOT YET WILLING TO ADOPT THE POLICY THAT WOULD BE CONSISTENT WITH THIS ROLE. LACK OF FIRMNESS ON THE PART OF THE UNITED STATES GIVES ISRAEL THE IMPRESSION THAT IT CAN COUNT ON AN AMERICAN BACKING REGARDLESS OF ITS POLICY TOWARD THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE.

IN THIS FRAMEWORK THE EUROPEAN COUNTRIES CAN AND SHOULD PLAY AN IMPORTANT PART TO ENSURE THAT THE AGGRESSION WOULD NOT BE REWARDED, THAT THE INDEPENDENCE OF LEBANON, ITS TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY AND SOVEREIGNTY WOULD BE RESPECTED AND THAT A JUST POLITICAL SOLUTION SHOULD BE SOUGHT TO THE PALESTINIAN PROBLEM INSTEAD OF THE ATTEMPT TO ANNIHILATE THE PALESTINIAN LEADERSHIP.
