OFFICIALS HERE STRESS THAT TIME IS RUNNING SHORT FOR THE DIPLOMATIC NEGOTIATIONS TO SUCCEED. THEY REITERATE PREMIER MENACHEM BEGIN'S STERN WARNING FROM THE KNESSET PODIUM OF TUESDAY NIGHT THAT "UNDER NO CONDITIONS WILL WE PERMIT THE PLU TO STAY IN BEIRUT." IN WASHINGTON, OFFICIALS ARE STRESSING THE DELICACY OF THIS STAGE OF THE BEIRUT NEGOTIATIONS UNDER SPECIAL ENVOY PHILIP HABIB.
