1. CONFIDENTIAL -- ENTIRE TEXT.

2. SUMMARY: AS MANY AS TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND
SUPPORTERS OF PRIME MINISTER BEGIN'S LEBANON POLICY
PACKED THE MAIN SQUARE OF TEL AVIV ON JULY 17
IN A FERVENT DISPLAY OF SOLIDARITY WITH THE
GOVERNMENT. BILLED AS A NON-POLITICAL EVENT, THE
RALLY STARRED MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR YOSEF BURG,
MINISTER OF DEFENSE, ARIEL SHARON, AND PRIME MINISTER
MENAHEM BEGIN. BEGIN WAS PERSISTENTLY HAILED AS
THE KING OF ISRAEL, AS HE AND SHARON EXPRESSED THEIR
COMMITMENT TO THE DESTRUCTION OF THE PLO AND THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF PEACE WITH LEBANON AND JORDAN. THE
CROWD, MAINLY LIKUD ENTHUSIASTS, AWARDED IDENTICAL
BOOES AND HISSES TO ALL MENTIONS OF BOTH ARAFAT AND
THE LABOR PARTY. THE RALLY, WHICH LASTED ABOUT TWO
HOURS, ENDED WITH THE SINGING OF HATIKVAH, THE
ISRAELI NATIONAL ANTHEM. PRIME MINISTER BEGIN
UNDOUBTEDLY WALKED AWAY FROM THE EVENT FEELING HE

3. A LARGE RALLY, ORGANIZED TO SHOW SUPPORT FOR THE GOVERNMENT'S LEBANON POLICY, TOOK PLACE IN TEL AVIV ON JULY 17. POLICE REFUSED TO ESTIMATE THE SIZE OF THE DENSE CROWD, BUT ORGANIZERS PUT THE NUMBER AT OVER TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND. POLOFF ESTIMATES FIFTY TO SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND, STILL A CONSIDERABLE GATHERING. MANY GOVERNMENT MINISTERS AND MANY KNESSET MEMBERS ATTENDED THE DEMONSTRATION ALONGSIDE THE MAYORS OF SEVERAL GALILEAN CITIES. DOZENS OF BUSES BROUGHT THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE TO THE SITE FROM ALL OVER THE COUNTRY. WHATEVER THE PRECISE TURNOUT, IT WAS MANY TIMES LARGER THAN THE PEACE NOW DEMONSTRATION ORGANIZED JULY 3.

4. EVENTS WERE EXTREMELY WELL ORGANIZED. SOME SEVEN HUNDRED POLICE AND BORDER PATROLMEN CLOSED THE ENTIRE AREA OFF TO TRAFFIC NEARLY THREE HOURS BEFORE THE RALLY COMMENCED; THOSE WHO CAME EARLY WERE TREATED TO A CONCERT OF INCONGRUOUSLY PEACEFUL FOLK MUSIC. TEL AVIV MAYOR SHLOMO LAHAT, WHO SPONSORED AND HELPED ORGANIZE THE DEMONSTRATION, HAD ALL THE LIGHTS IN CITY HALL (DIRECTLY BEHIND THE DAIS) TURNED ON FOR THE OCCASION, AND HAD ERECTED A HUGE ELECTRICALLY LIGHTED SIGN CARRYING THE LEGEND "TO THE IDF, WITH LOVE." THE DIGNITARIES' PLATFORM WAS DRAPED WITH ENORMOUS FLAGS AND BANNERS BEARING THE STAR OF DAVID, AND THE MENDRAH, EMBLEM OF THE STATE. THESE TWIN MOTIFS PROVIDED NOT ONLY A PATRIOTIC ATMOSPHERE, BUT AN INDISPUTABLY OFFICIAL ONE AS WELL. WE NOTE TOO THAT THROUGHOUT THE DAY OF THE RALLY A HELICOPTER TRAVERSED THE SKIES OF TEL AVIV TRAILING A STREAMER INVITING CITIZENS TO JOIN THE PRIME MINISTER AT A DEMONSTRATION THAT EVENING. ALL IN ALL, A WELL PLANNED, WELL EXECUTED HAPPENING.

5. THE PREVAILING MOOD WAS SERIOUS. THE THRONG-- PREDOMINANTLY SEPHARDIC, BUT PEPPERED WITH SMALL GROUPS OF YIDDISH SPEAKING EUROPEAN JEWS--CARRIED PRINTED SIGNS SAYING: "SHARON EQUALS SECURITY," "WHO REMEMBERS THE OLYMPIC MASSACRES," "GRATITUDE TO THE

ESPECIALLY THE SLAUGHTER OF THE INNOCENTS AT MAALOT.

TO BURG, A DISASTER ON PAR WITH THE SACK OF JERUSALEM IN 70 A.D. HAD BEEN NARROWLY AVERTED BY THE IDF IN RECENT WEEKS. WERE IT NOT FOR "PEACE FOR GALILEE," THE FLAG OF THE PLO MIGHT SOON HAVE FLOWN IN TEL AVIV. ADHERENTS OF THE PEACE NOW MOVEMENT (OUTBURST OF BOOS AND WHISTLES) WERE IGNORANT OF HISTORY AND WOULD HAVE PAST TRAGEDIES REPEATED. ARAFAT, HE CONTINUED, SITS WITH JEWS ON TELEVISION IN BEIRUT, WHILE HE KILLS THEM IN MAALOT. AND AS FOR IRAN AND IRAQ, BOTH ARE TO BE WISHED GOOD LUCK.

7. SHARON WAS BRIEF AND TO THE POINT: ISRAEL HAS ALWAYS BEEN A NATION OF BUILDERS AND FIGHTERS AND SO SHE CONTINUES TO BE; VIA THE AUTONOMY PLAN ISRAEL HAS EXTENDED A HAND TO THE ARABS, ONLY TO BE VIOLENTLY REBUFFED BY THE PLO, ITS SYRIAN PATRONS AND EUROPEAN FRIENDS, LIKE BRUND KREISKY (OUTBURST OF BOOS AND HISSES). REBUFFS NOTWITHSTANDING, THERE WILL NEVER BE A PALESTINIAN STATE, SAID SHARON, AND THE SOONER PALESTINIANS COME TO GRIPS WITH THAT FACT, THE SOONER THEY WILL CEASE TO BE MANIPULATED BY THE ARAB STATES. CONCERNING OPPONENTS OF THE WAR, HE BELLOWED, "PEACE NOW, SHUT UP NOW!...WE HAVE GIVEN NEGOTIATIONS A CHANCE." DURING SHARON'S SPEECH, THE CROWD HAD SPONTANEOUSLY SURGED FORWARD, INTENT ON HIS WORDS. AT ONE POINT, POLOFF ASKED NEIGHBOR FOR THE TRANSLATION OF AN OBSCURE PHRASE. IN RESPONSE, THE NEIGHBOR GRABBED POLOFF BY HIS SHOULDERS AND YELLED, "THE PLO -- HE'S TALKING ABOUT THE PLO; THEY ARE BASTARDS, SONS OF BITCHES AND THE SCUM OF THE EARTH!"

8. REFTTEL CONVEYS THE GIST OF PRIME MINISTER BEGIN'S REMARKS. THE PRIME MINISTER CAME TO THE PODIUM TO WILD CHANTS, AGAIN, OF "BEGIN, KING OF ISRAEL." BEFORE THE CHEERS HAD SUBSIDED, HE DECLARED THAT THE GOVERNMENT HAD PROMISED PEACE FOR GALILEE AND DELIVERED. AS HE SPOKE THE CROWD APPEARED TO BE FULLY ENGAGED; POLOFF OBSERVED UPTURNED HEADS ALL AROUND, EYES FIXED ON THE PRIME MINISTER. ISRAELIS, BEGIN SAID, SHOULD OFFER THE BIRKAT HAGOMEL, THE TRADITIONAL PRAYER OF THOSE WHO HAVE NARROWLY ESCAPED DESTRUCTION. THE ALIGNMENT WAS DESCRIBED IN MOST VITUPERATIVE TERMS AS VENAL, AND THE ROOT OF ALL DISSENT. WHY, ASKED BEGIN, COULD THERE NOT BE LOVE OF ISRAEL INSTEAD OF HATRED OF THE GOVERNMENT? HORSEWHIPPING LABOR ELICITED AN APPRECIATIVE ROAR FROM THE CROWD. THE ALIGNMENT, HE WENT ON, HAD NOT EXER-
