DRAWING ON REFTEL I SAID I ASSUMED THAT THE ISRAELIS WERE EAGER TO HAVE ELECTIONS SOON AND THAT I HAD A PRETTY GOOD IDEA THAT THEIR FAVORITE CANDIDATE FACED THE PROBLEM OF GETTING A QUORUM.
