2. SPORADIC ISRAELI SHELLING OF WEST BEIRUT CONTINUED THROUGH THE NIGHT OF AUGUST 4-5. SINCE APPROXIMATELY 0730 LOCAL, THE CITY HAS BEEN QUIET. AS OF 1300 LOCAL, WE CANNOT OBSERVE ANY SIGNS OF MILITARY ACTIVITY FROM THE RESIDENCE.

3. ALL EAST-WEST CROSSINGS WERE CLOSED TO VEHICLE TRAVIC THIS MORNING. PORT GATES WERE CLOSED AND, FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE INVASION NO VEHICLES WERE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE PORT.

4. THE BLOCKED CROSSINGS AND LACK OF TELEPHONE COMMUNICATIONS MAKE IT IMPOSSIBLE TO GET A CLEAR, ACCURATE PICTURE OF WHAT HAPPENED YESTERDAY IN BEIRUT. OFFICIAL RADIO LEBANON REPORTS THAT THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION, CENTRAL BANK, AND PM'S OFFICE, ALL IN THE HAMRA AREA WERE HIN IN YESTERDAY'S SHELLING AS WERE NINE HOSPITALS AND SERVERAL HOTELS, INCLUDING THE COMMUDORE (HEADQUARTERS FOR FOREIGN CORRESPONDENTS IN WEST BEIRUT). 3. DIPLOMATIC DEVELOPMENTS: AMBASSADOR HABIB HAS RESUMED NEGOTIATIONS IN BEIRUT.

THE SECURITY COUNCIL, BY A VOTE OF 14-0 WITH THE U.S. ABSTAINING, VOTED, INTER ALIA, TO DEMAND AN IMMEDIATE CEASEFIRE AND WITHDRAWAL OF ISRAELI FORCES FROM LEBANON, TO CENSURE ISRAEL FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH UN RESOLUTIONS 508, 509, 512, 513, 515, AND 516, AND TO CALL FOR THE RETURN OF ISRAELI TROOPS TO THEIR POSITIONS OF AUGUST 1. THE U.S. DELEGATE EXPLAINED THAT THE U.S. COULD NOT SUPPORT THE RESOLUTION BECAUSE IT DID NOT CALL FOR THE IMMEDIATE WITHDRAWAL OF THE PLO FROM LEBANON. IN CASE OF NON-COMPLIANCE BY ANY PARTY TO THE CONFLICT THE SECURITY COUNCIL WOULD CONSIDER ADOPTING EFFECTIVE WAYS AND MEANS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE UN CHARTER.

UPI REPORTS THAT THE PLO WOULD AGREE TO A WITHDRAWAL WHICH OCCURRED SIMULTANEOUSLY WITH THE DEPLOYMENT OF A MULTINATIONAL FORCE RATHER THAN HOLD OFF A WITHDRAWAL UNTIL THE FORCE IS DEPLOYED.

4. OTHER DEVELOPMENTS: ISRAEL HAS ANNOUNCED PRICE INCREASES FOR BASIC FOODSTUFFS AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AS SUBSIDIES WERE REDUCED TO FINANCE THE WAR EFFORT.
