2. MILITARY SITUATION: BEIRUT REMAINED QUIET THROUGHOUT THE DAY, AS A DE FACTO CEASEFIRE PREVAILED OVER THE CITY. ISRAELI TROOPS HAVE MAINTAINED THEIR POSITIONS AT THE LAF SHIHAB BARRACKS ALONG THE COAST AND AT THE MUSEUM AND PORT CROSSINGS IN BEIRUT, WHICH ARE NOW CLOSED TO VEHICLE TRAFFIC. EMBASSY BEIRUT CONFIRMED PRESS REPORTS THAT THE GALERIE SIMMAN CROSSING WAS OPEN; LOCAL PRESS REPORTS CLAIMED THAT THE CROSSING WAS FLOODED WITH CIVILIANS TRYING TO LEAVE WEST BEIRUT. AT APPUROXIMATELY 1300 LOCAL, A BOMB EXPLODED IN THE PARKING LOT OF THE ALEXANDER HOTEL IN EAST BEIRUT. NONE OF THE AMERICANS RESIDING IN THE HOTEL—AMONG THEM, AID EMPLOYEES, JOURNALISTS AND RELIEF WORKERS—WERE INJURED. MEANWHILE, THE FOOD AND POWER SITUATION IN WEST BEIRUT REMAINS

CRITICAL. ELECTRICITY HAS NOT YET BEEN RESTORED AND, BECAUSE OF THE CLOSURE OF THE PORT AND MUSEUM CROSSINGS, SHIPMENTS OF FOOD AND MEDICINE ARE UNABLE TO REACH RESIDENTS IN THE WESTERN SECTORS OF THE CITY.
