MESSAGE / ANNOTATION:

BEIRUT REMAINS INTACT, AND THE PLO/ADF EVACUATION IS IN ITS FINAL PHASE. TODAY PLO CHAIRMAN YASIR ARAFAT AND 50 UTHER PASSENGERS BOARDED THE "ATLANTIS" AND DEPARTED BEIRUT AT 1143 LOCAL FOR GREECE. LEBANON'S PRIME MINISTER SHAFIQ AL-WAZZAN AND NATIONAL MOVEMENT HEAD WALID JUMBLATT SAW ARAFAT OFF AT THE PORT OF BEIRUT. THE "SOL GEORGIUS" LEFT BEIRUT AT 1630 LOCAL CARRYING 588 PLO COMBATANTS, 28 WOMEN AND 12 CHILDREN WHO WILL GO TO ALGERIA. ROUGHLY 1200 ADF (SYRIAN) TROOPS ALSO LEFT WEST BEIRUT IN AN OVERLAND CONVOY ALONG THE DAMASCUS HIGHWAY TO SYRIA. IN CONTRAST TO THE PLU, THE ADF HAS BEEN ALLOWED TO CARRY ALONG ITS HEAVY EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING TANKS AND ARTILLERY. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PLO EVACUEES TO DATE IS 6,700, WHILE ADF AND OTHER EVACUEES TOTAL 4,000. RADIO JERUSALEM CLAIMS THE PLO HAS VIOLATED THE EVACUATION PLAN BY TURNING OVER ITS HEAVY WEAPONS TO LEFTIST MILITIAS IN WEST BEIRUT RATHER THAN TO THE LAF.

IDF RADIO IN TEL AVIV REPORTS AN IDF PATROL HIT A LAND MINE NEAR THE VILLAGE OF KAMID AL-LAWZ IN SOUTH LEBANON AND THAT ONE IDF SOLDIER WAS WOUNDED. THE BROADCAST ALSO CLAIMS THE IDF PATROL WAS FIRED ON FROM SYRIAN-CONTROLLED TERRITORY.
