ARAFAT BLAMED THE ISRAELIS FOR THE DEATH OF GEMAYEL, CLAIMING THAT IT SERVED TEL AVIV'S INTEREST TO KEEP THE COUNTRY DIVIDED.

- 4. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS ON FOREIGN MINISTER COLOMBO'S MEETING WITH ARAFAT, THE FORMER CLAIMED THAT ITALY, ALONG WITH OTHER EC COUNTRIES, INTENDS TO SUPPORT THE PLO ON A POLITICAL BASIS, AS OPPOSED TO A MILITARY ONE. COLOMBO REPORTEDLY RE-AFFIRMED GOI'S VIEW THAT THE PALESTINIANS HAVE A RIGHT TO A HOMELAND AND THAT ISRAEL HAS A RIGHT TO EXIST (SEE SEPTEL).
- 5. IN RESPONSE, AGAIN ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, ARAFAT EXPRESSED HIS CONCERN TO COLOMBO OVER THE RETURN TO VIOLENCE IN LEBANON AND THE REFUSAL OF ISRAEL TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS (AS EVIDENCED BY THE ISRAELI REJECTION OF PRESIDENT REAGAN'S PEACE PLAN.) ARAFAT APPARENTLY THANKED ITALY FOR ITS SUPPORT OF THE PLO AND CONFIRMED HIS DESIRE TO SEEK A NEGOTIATED SOLUTION AS PROPOSED BY THE ARAB SUMMIT AT FEZ.

TODAY, ANOTHER MAN CAME FROM PALESTIME. I AM NOT A FISHERMAN, BUT AN ENGINEER. BUT I ALSO WANT TO TALK TO THE HEARTS OF ROMANS, SO THAT THEY CAN SUPPORT THE CAUSE OF MY PEOPLE WHO SUFFER."

THE CHICL'S VIEW, THE PRESIDENT'S MEETING WITH
ARAFAT, ALONG WITH PERTINI'S REMARKS ON SEPTEMBER 14
