I have reviewed the personal and financial information submitted to the Justice Department by Edward R. Korman in connection with his possible nomination to the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York, and see no legal or other conflicts which should preclude his nomination.

The only potential problem discussed in his responses to the Justice Department questionnaire is an ongoing discrimination suit in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, in which he is named as one of apparently several defendants. The suit was brought by an unsuccessful applicant to be a New York City Marshal, who was recommended for that position by the Mayor's Committee on New York City Marshals, of which Mr. Korman was Chairman. In view of the fact that the Mayor, and not the Committee, made the determination not to hire her, this litigation would not appear to pose any problems in connection with Mr. Korman's prospective nomination.



Dear Ed:




