CHINA HALTS U.S. AGRICULTURAL PURCHASES

PEKING (UPI) -- CHINA SAID TODAY IT WILL IMMEDIATELY STOP BUYING AMERICAN COTTON, CHEMICAL FIBERS AND SOYBEANS AND REDUCE ITS PLANNED IMPORTS OF OTHER U.S. AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS IN APPARENT RETALIATION FOR U.S. TEXTILE QUOTAS.

THE ANNOUNCEMENT MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN ECONOMIC RELATIONS AND TRADE CAME FIVE DAYS AFTER WASHINGTON IMPOSED UNILATERAL QUOTAS ON CHINESE TEXTILE SALES TO THE UNITED STATES TO PROTECT THE RECESSION-PLAGUED DOMESTIC TEXTILE INDUSTRY.

AFTER TEXTILE NEGOTIATIONS BROKE DOWN FRIDAY IN PEKING, CHINA WARNED IT WOULD "RESPOND STRONGLY" TO ANY UNILATERAL RESTRICTIONS.

BOTH SIDES HAVE EXPRESSED INTEREST IN CONTINUING NEGOTIATIONS TO SOLVE THE ISSUE, THE MOST BITTER DISPUTE TO ERUPT IN U.S.-CHINA TRADE, BUT NO NEW BARGAINING DATE HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED.

CHINA IS SEEKING TO CONTINUE TEXTILE EXPORTS TO AMERICA AT A 6 PERCENT ANNUAL GROWTH RATE BUT THE REAGAN ADMINISTRATION WANTS A LIMIT OF ABOUT 1.5 PERCENT.

AMERICAN FARM PRODUCTS ARE THE LARGEST EXPORT TO CHINA FROM THE UNITED STATES.

FROM: NORMAN A. BAILEY *NAB*SUBJECT: Proposal on the Formation of the Pacific
Basin Cooperation Council

For some time now, the economic and technological center of the world has been shifting to the Pacific Basin. This evident fact is in no way reflected in American political, military or diplomatic strategy. Even in the economic field, trade conflicts over secondary issues (fruit, beef, baseball bats) are emphasized to the detriment of primary ones (security, energy, investment, technological cooperation, etc.).

Our relationship with Japan is the most important bilateral relationship that we have, except for the Soviet Union, and yet we are often perceived as being (and quite often are) aligned with the Europeans, some of whom are worse than the Japanese on trade issues, against them.

One problem is that the Japanese are not in NATO and peripheral to the OECD, which is a very Europe-centered organization.

As a centerpiece to the Nakasone visit follow-up, I propose that the USG suggest the establishment of a "Pacific Basin Cooperation Council" to be made up of Japan, the U.S., Canada, South Korea, the ASEAN countries, Australia and New Zealand. The Council could deal with all the issues that the OECD deals with but in a Pacific Basin context. An additional advantage would be closer cooperation with Australia, which as you know is unhappy at its exclusion from the Summit process.

Gaston Sigur, David Laux, Roger Robinson and Bill Martin concur. Comments from Dick Childress and Henry Nau are attached at Tab I.

RECOMMENDATION:

That you authorize us to pursue this idea in the interagency process.

SUBJECT: Pacific Basin Cooperation Council

I'm with you through the first three paragraphs, then I begin to have some concerns. We have major demands on us from many of the Asian nations to lift tariffs, uphold commodity prices, increase ESF, FMS and other forms of aid. We have not been able to remotely fill their needs. I'm very concerned that the formation of such a council, in the absence of signs of a general economic upturn globally will raise expectations that could not be met. In several instances, I can visualize conflicts of interests between certain Asian states on economic questions that we could be drawn into if we take any sort of lead.

Before proceeding, should we not be sure that:

- We will be able to meet expected demands.
- Potential intra-Asian conflicts are identified first.
- Expectations not exceed results, thus damaging our credibility further?
- Mechanisms for identifying who leads whom are identified.
- We cannot accomplish something concrete more effectively bilaterally with increased priority to Asia rather than an umbrella such as this.

Henry Nau's comments, next under, raise additional questions.

SUBJECT:

Pacific Basin Cooperation Council

The formation of a Pacific Basin Cooperation Council is an interesting idea. But it is potentially a significant step and should be developed with some pros and cons before we seek Clark's reactions.

For example, for 25 years we have been Japan's patron in seeking entrance for Japan in the global economic and trading organizations (GATT, OECD, etc.). Is a Pacific Basin economic organization, which competes with OECD, a 180 degree departure from this historic policy.

Further, is it wise to organize ourselves in a regional organization where we alone, without Europe, may have to bear the brunt of Japanese economic and export prowess? Will not such an organization make it easier for the Europeans to limit Japanese access to their markets even further, diverting Japanese exports to the U.S.?

What would the creation of PBCC mean for Japanese participation in vital aid efforts organized through OECD for European countries, such as Turkey, Yugoslavia, etc.?
