You'll recall that after a comprehensive review of our China policy, in June 1981 the President decided to create a new Joint Commission on Commerce and Trade to give extraordinary attention to this aspect of our relationship. Previously, trade had been one component part of a joint economic committee chaired on our side by Don Regan.

Only recently has the Chinese government agreed to implement this JCCT, following up on commitments to do so a year earlier. We believe this to be a matter of special significance on their part. As agreed, in late May 1983 I will lead a mission to China with broad interagency representation for the first meeting of this new Commission.

Given the importance of this event, I believe it is essential to designate this a Presidential mission which would be fully supported by U.S. Air Force transport. Your assistance is requested in acquiring this designation and support.
