You sent Gaston and me a note saying Faith Whittlesey had passed you Anna Chennault's card with the attached paper (Tab A) and asked what it meant.

LIAO Chengchih, a top official in the Chinese government\* in Beijing, died of a heart attack on June 11. LIAO was Anna's "uncle" (actually a cousin), and the PRC Embassy here has invited her to attend the funeral. She will go.

Anna was interested, we believe, in whether or not she could pass some sort of message from the President to Deng Xiaoping or Premier Zhao Ziyang. There does not appear to be any need to do so. State has sent a telegram to our Embassy in Beijing (Tab B) suggesting the DCM make appropriate expressions of condolence to the PRC government.

Gaston Sigur concurs.
