You sent Gaston and me a note saying Faith Whittlesey had passed you Anna Chennault's card with the attached paper (Tab A) and asked what it meant.

LIAO Chengchih, a top official in the Chinese government* in Beijing, died of a heart attack on June 11. LIAO was Anna's "uncle" (actually a cousin), and the PRC Embassy here has invited her to attend the funeral. She will go.

Anna was interested, we believe, in whether or not she could pass some sort of message from the President to Deng Xiaoping or Premier Zhao Ziyang. There does not appear to be any need to do so. State has sent a telegram to our Embassy in Beijing (Tab B) suggesting the DCM make appropriate expressions of condolence to the PRC government.

Dear David:

Given current uncertainties about the state of Sino-Soviet relations, I think you will find of special interest the two enclosed studies of the Soviet military buildup against the Chinese by Harry Gelman of our staff.

The analyses conclude that the Soviets probably believe they have been successful in intimidating the Chinese via their military deployments in the Far East, and are unlikely to make significant concessions to Beijing in the current "normalization" talks. This conclusion implies that the Chinese may soon see the limits of their diplomatic approach to reducing the Soviet threat to PRC security.

I know that the combined thinkness of these reports may be a bit off-putting, but the classified version is rather brief, and both contain executive summaries. I hope you will find them of value.

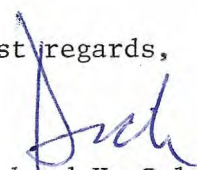
