Home is where love and care are!

For 90 children, Sanhedria is home and it gives them what any real home should — the love, care and encouragement which are so vital for healthy growth. Sanhedria Children's Home was founded in 1943 at the initiative of the world renowned Brisker Rav, Rabbi Yitzchak Ze'ev Soloveichick, to provide a home for refugee children who were then arriving from Eastern Europe. It was originally situated in the Sanhedria quarter of Jerusalem — hence the name — and moved to its present location after its premises were destroyed in Israel's War of Independence.

Sanhedria has since developed into a home for boys, many of them orphans, who come from severely deprived social environments. Most of the children have never known the warmth and security of a Jewish family atmosphere and arrive at Sanhedria retarded in their educational achievements and suffering from emotional and social instability . . . The children range in age from 5 to 15 and

are referred to Sanhedria by the Ministry of Social Welfare which provides for their basic upkeep, an income which represents some 50% of the total budget. The children live at Sanhedria and attend local schools. Sanhedria supplies all the care and attention that a normal warm, loving home would give its children and, most importantly, provides them with the "extras" which, in reality, are as necessary as food and clothing. In the afternoon, the home provides a wide range of educational and recreational programmes designed to develop the children's capabilities and help them overcome the neglect of their early childhood. These activities include: play therapy, free expressional art work, music, photography, handicrafts and woodwork, and an individual coaching programme to enable the children to catch up with their peer group at school. All these activities are supervised by trained teachers and counsellors under the guidance of a psychologist.

The after-school programmes are not funded by any government agency but, like the building development, are dependent on the generosity of Sanhedria's friends. Children who would have been — and indeed were educationally and emotionally stunted are blossoming at Sanhedria. Since Sanhedria was founded more than 1,000 children have been graduated and have continued their education at vocational training schools or yeshiva high schools and completed their full national service. Were it not for Sanhedria it is doubtful whether most of these young men would have become the productive selfrespecting citizens that they are. Sanhedria is a home where each child is

treated as an individual and its success is due to the close personal relationship that exists between the children and the dedicated professional staff. Because of space limitations, Sanhedria can admit only one out of every ten applicants. It could accept twice as many children if only it had more dormitories and the space for after-school activities and still be able to give them the individual attention every child deserves. Although some structural changes have been made over the past few years, including the addition of a dormitory wing, the extension of the dining room and the creation of a new synagogue/club room. Sanhedria has reached the maximum utilization of its cramped quarters. More space is urgently needed. Plans have already been approved by the city authorities for a 3-storied extension

building which will contain: new dormitories, a dining hall and kitchen, a clinic, workshops, a synagogue, study rooms and designed play areas. Together with its existing premises, Sanhedria will be able to accommodate 150 children. Sanhedria believes that every child has the right to live in a good home and for those who have not been fortunate enough to have their own, Sanhedria is determined to provide it. Sanhedria is blessed in having devoted




