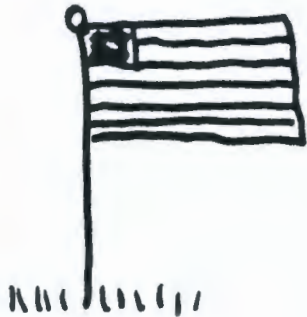

If this reaches you at the address I'm sending it to, I'll explain later.

I am going to try to freshen your memory to see if you recall our meeting 14 years ago.

It was the fall of 1966, with the Campaigne trail taking you many places, you visited the Republican Headquarters in Lafayette, Ca. one Saturday.

At the time I was Chairman for the Concord, Ca. Headquarters. All of us in the area grouped together to welcome you that day. I had my two children, ages 6 and 3½, who were dressed in red, white and blue outfits and waving little American flags, when you arrived.

3) of course I first met Ronnie back in 1964 when he campaigned for Barry Goldwater. He'd never remember that though except my friend and I did ask him to do something special for us when he got back to Hollywood. We asked him to give John Wayne a kiss for us. He replied that he'd better shake his hand since Washington had enough funny stuff going on at that time.

I thought there would be a better chance of you receiving it now instead of waiting until you moved to the White House. 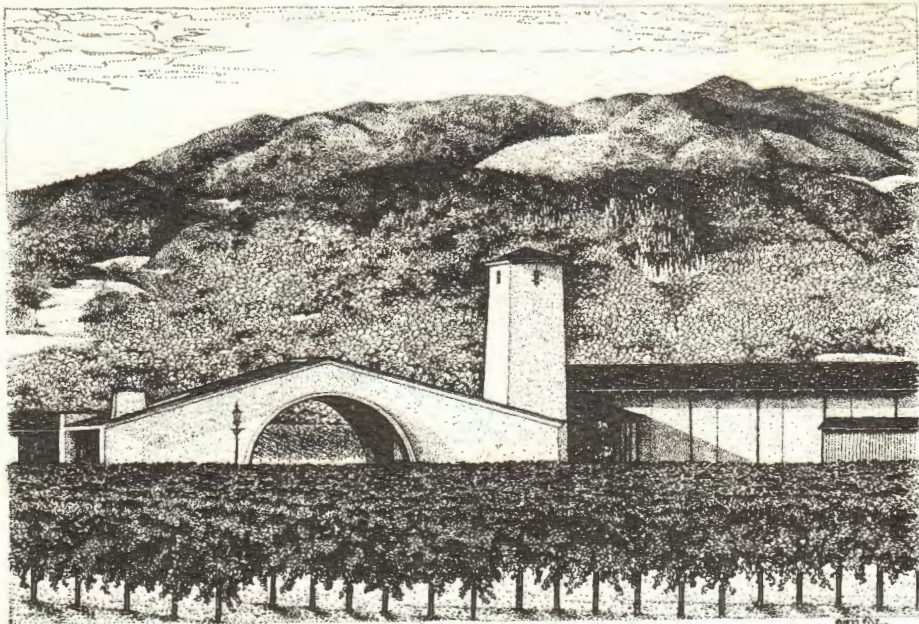
