
This week the Mayor of Del Rio, Texas and one of the City Councilmen presented me with the enclosed bottle of wine for President Reagan.

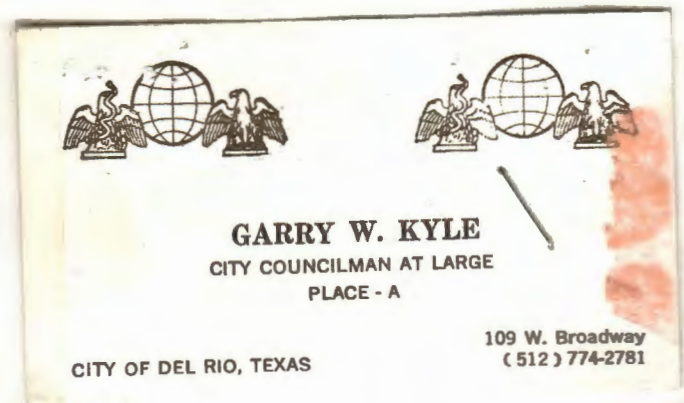
