Dear Mr. President:

I teach welding at San Jacinto College North Campus in Houston, Texas. One of my hobbies is welding sculpture. I am not an artist, nor am I trying to establish myself as one. I am a teacher and I really enjoy my work. I wanted to do something for you to show you that I am pleased that you will be our leader for the next four (eight, I hope) important years. I am not wealthy and so I turned to my hobby to create something that I hope you will like. It is not a perfect sculpture, but it is not supposed to be. I guess what I enjoy most about welding sculptures is that each piece is an original piece. This sculpture that I am sending you is one of a kind from memory, so it may not be exact.

The twenty mule team was handcrafted. Each mule was made from railroad spikes, with nails for legs, formed steel for ears, and bronzed wire for the tails. The feet are crafted from nuts. The bronzed wire was also used for the collars and bridles.

The borax wagon is made of steel and bronze wire, the wheels of rolled bronzed wire that was silver brazed, with the bronze wire inserts also silver brazed.

The water wagon is made of brass shim stock that was rolled and soldered. The wheels were made the same as on the borax wagon.

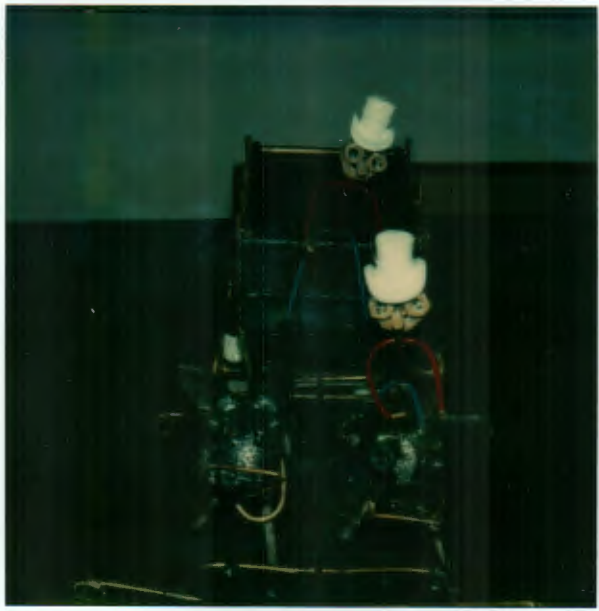
The driver and rider are made of formed welding wire, nuts and bolts, all hand welded and painted. 72" long, 100 lbs.

I realize that this gift is not as fine as many others that you will receive. I hope that you will accept it and even like it; it is the best thing that I can send you, something that I made with my hands and my heart.

Good luck at the toughest job in the world from one of us average guys who believe in you.


