The rice is harvested here in late August, so if you use this up and are in need of more, please let us know. Also, we would be interested in your opinion of how our rice tasted.

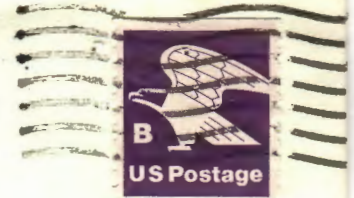

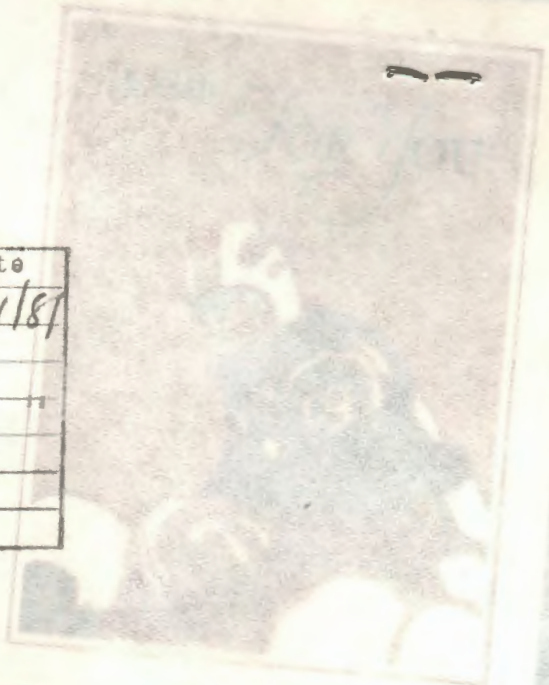
