





Appreciate your offer of assistance -- let me give you some specifics and get your thoughts on the same.

I specifically commissioned wildlife artist Lorenzo E. Ghiglieri of Portland, Oregon, to create the life-size bronze American Bald Eagle (President Reagan already has in his personal collection at least one piece that this artist has done) -- Remember, this is a life-size eagle, approximately four feet tall with an actual wingspan in excess of five feet and weighs almost 200 pounds.

Dan -- it is a magnificent piece and will take me a couple of months to obtain one from the foundry. It was my idea that perhaps we could present the same to the President on or about July 4. It just seemed to me that with the theme "America: A New Beginning," that this piece is most appropriate.

I will personally make the same available -- I want nothing in return except that we figure out how to arrange that President Reagan will personally accept the same.

Do we give it to him personally? -- Do we give it to "the people of America" received by President Reagan? -- We do need to get a bit of planning done ahead of schedule -- How do you go about guaranteeing that President Reagan will accept the bronze and accept it personally?

Due to the size of the same, it seems to me that some preliminary "set up work" should be done with the assistance of one of his aides. All I am telling you is that this piece is magnificent and big and costs a hell of a lot of money, and I want to present the same without any potential interpretation of commercial consideration.

Gail and I will simply bring the piece to Washington and hopefully with and through your assistance and guidance we can then present the same to the President. Pr 15 - 2

What about presenting the same from "the people of Indiana"?

Let me know at your earliest convenience the "modus operandi" you feel we should follow to be able to in fact personally present this bronze to President Reagan -- I will then order the casting from the foundry.

I respectfully await your reply on the aforementioned.


