IN EVERY KIND OF A POLITICAL SITUATION THERE HAS TO BE A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF ADJUSTMENT. DKAY. THE JAPANESE SAW THE HANDWRITING ON THE WALL AND THEREFORE TOOK THE REQUISITE ACTION. 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DO NOT INTEND TO FLAGELLATE DUR FRIENDS IN PUBLIC. THERE ARE OTHER WAYS OF BRINGING ATTENTION TO BEAR ON THE QUESTION AND THESE OTHER WAYS MAY PROVE TO BE FAR MORE EFFECTIVE THAN PUBLIC PRESSURE, WHICH ONLY MAKES TENSIONS, FORCES LEADERS AND COUNTRIES INTO CORNERS AND MAKE THE REACTIONS UNPREDICTABLE. WE HAVE SEEN WHAT'S HAPPENED IN KIM DAE JONG AND THERE HAVE BEEN OTHER EPISODES SINCE THEN WHICH SUGGEST TO ME THAT KOREA UNDERSTANDS THE PROBLEM AND IS POINTING IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION. I CAN SAY THE SAME FOR OTHER COUNTRIES IN EAST ASIA AS WELL. BT #6241 NNNN

SPEAKS CINCPAC FOR USICA ADVISOR USINFO FOR PGM/PPF OUR JUDGEMENT ANY ACCOMMODATION TO VIET NAM IN THE HOPES THAT IT WOULD PERHAPS BECOME LESS TROUBLESOME, THAT IT WOULD MODERATE ITS PLICIES, THAT WILL NOT MAKE MUCH SENSE. OUR OWN HISTROY WITH THE VIETNAMESE OVER THE YEARS SUGGESTS THAT THEY ARE VERY TOUGH PEOPLE, AND IF YOU GIVE THEM WHAT THEY WANT THIS DOESN'T MAKE THEM CHANGE THEIR PULICY IN ANY WAY. SO WE WILL SEEK IF WE CAN, FIND WAYS TO INCREASE THE POLITICAL, ECONOMIC AND, YES, MILITARY PRESSURES ON VIET NAM WORKING WITH OTHERS, AND IN WAYS WHICH WILL BRING ABOUT, WE HOPE, SOME CHANGE IN HANDI'S ATTITUDE TOWARD THE SITUATION. A THIRD AREA OF CONCERN IS THE ANZUS REGION OF THE SOUTH WEST PACIFIC. WE'VE HAD AN ALLIANCE WITH THE ANZUZ POWERS, AUSTRALIA, NEW ZEALAND, NOW GOING BACK FOR AT LEAST TWENTY YEARS, AND THIS HAS BEEN VERY HELPFUL IN TERMS OF BRINGING ABOUT A GREATER DEGREE OF COOPERATION MILITARILY.

THINK THE FACT THAT WE HAVE A RELATIONSHIP OF THIS SORT BRINGS US CLOSER TOGETHER POLITICALLY AND, I MIGHT EVEN SAY, EMOTIONALLY. THERE ARE LOTS OF

PROBLEMS TO BE SURE, AND IN AUSTRALIA, IF WE LOOK AT THE NEWSPAPERS, ALMOST EVERY DAY THERE IS SOME ARTICLE THAT HAS SOME GRIPE ABOUT THE DEFENSE RELATIONSHIP WITH THE UNITED STATES. THE CONTRIBUTION OF AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND TO THE STABILITY OF SOUTH EAST ASIA THROUGH SOMETHING CALLED THE FPDA, THE FIVE POWER DEFENSE ARRANGEMENT BY WHICH THE AUSTRALIANS HAVE TWO SQUADRONS OF MIRAGE STATIONED AT BUTTERSWORTH IN MALAYSIA, AND THE NEW ZEALANDERS HAVE A BATTALION REINFORCED OF THEIR TROOPS IN SINGAPORE.
