
It would be a pleasure and an honor if you find the bronze elephant acceptable as a gift from me, in behalf of the many grateful citizens throughout our nation.

I have scheduled with the foundry to have the elephant cast in bronze on the very day you are to be inaugurated as President of these United States Of America.


It would be a pleasure and an honor if you would accept this momento of your inauguration as a gift from me, in behalf of grateful citizens thru out our great nation.

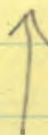



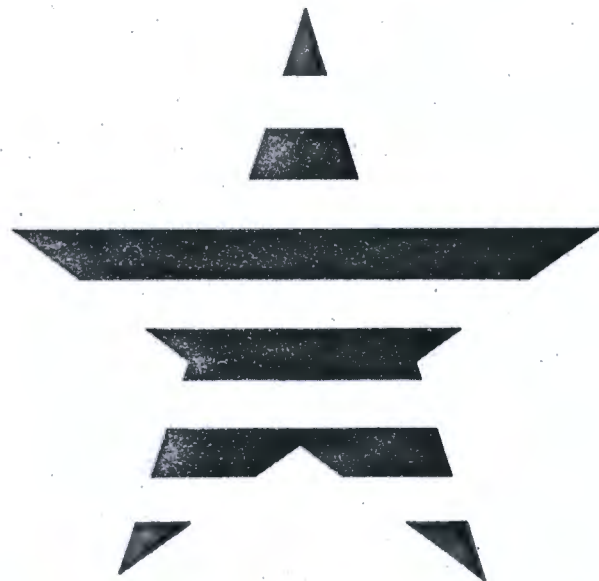
