Hand-made Cloisonné Beer Mug
featuring a good omen of pine, bamboo, plum and chrysanthemum

The origin of cloisonné can be traced back to remote ancient Egypt, and history brought it all the way to Japan through the Silk Road.

A mold of pure copper is glazed repeatedly with cloisonné and is completed into an ideal beer mug, which can also be displayed as an artistic ornament.

Maintenance of Cloisonné Beer Mug

Rub it every day with soft flannel to maintain its luster and wash it with household cleanser when it is stained.

Hot drinks should be avoided, due to the nature of cloisonné.

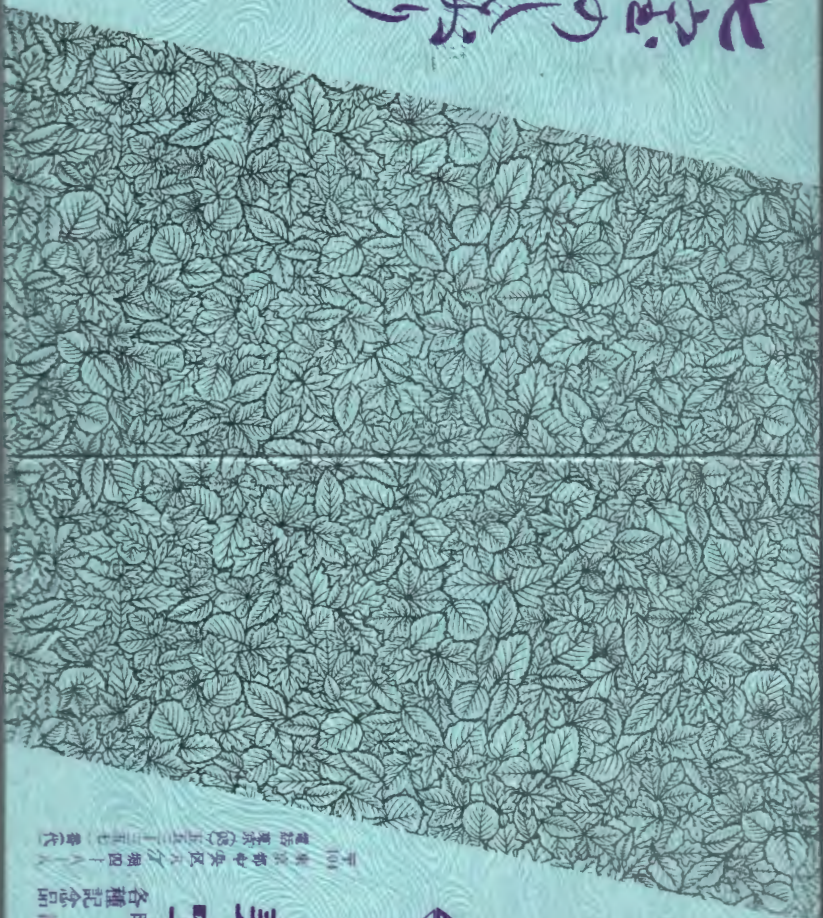


