Dear President Reagan:

I, like millions of Americans tonight are thankful that God spared you for the job which you were asked to do for us. We pray for His continued help in making it possible for you and the ones who were stricken down with you a few days ago, to regain health and strength and be able to cope with their jobs during these troublesome times.

I was in the Williamsport Hospital, Williamsport, Pennsylvania saying so-long to an appendix and a gall bladder, and my room-mate was a young man from Renovo, Pennsylvania who had recovered from a brain tumor operation. He came from a large family, he and a Sister helped the Mother support six other small children after loss of their Father and Husband in a railroad accident. Making a long story short, enough money was raised to send him home safely with extra cash to hold over for a while, but this episode gave my Wife and I the idea of sending get well cards, letters and flowers to those we knew of in the Hospitals who were not getting these things. We started to save magazines and jokes, poems, articles were saved, and Scrap Books made up when someone needed cheering up. Since 1942 Edna and I have made up twelve hundred and forty Scrap Books similar to the one we made up for you. We hope you like yours and that it helps you ease away from the tremendous burden of your job even for a few minutes once in a while.

Have your friends sign your book anywhere there is a vacant place, and your official family toward the back in their special pages, thus giving you a complete Log of your stay at George Washington University Hospital.

The best to you, your Dear Wife Nancy, the brave men who tried to shield you at the risk of losing their lives. God Bless you.



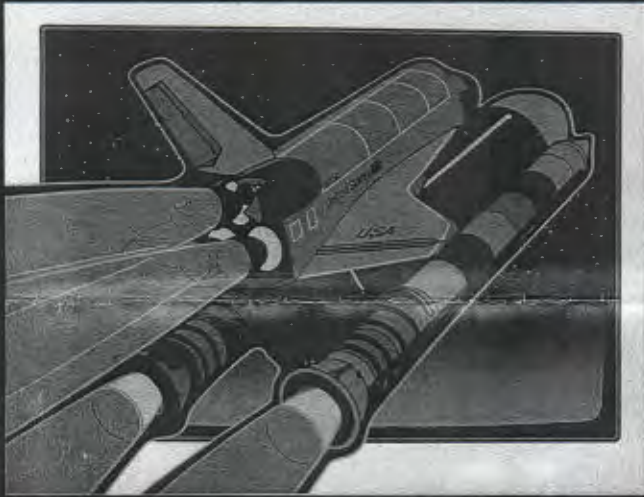


