

In 1972, Greig lost his eyesight over a period of three months. After many battles with depression, despair, fear and hopelessness, Greig gave the Lord Jesus everything; he gave Him absolute control in his life. It has been a long difficult road for the entire family. During this time of spiritual neglect and emptiness, Sondra too, had reached the spiritual "pits." Finally, seeing just how low a Christian can become, she saw her own desperate need for an all powerful God to forgive and do the now almost impossible; heal her broken mess of a marriage. Greig and Sondra trusted God against their own finite intelligence and understanding, and witnessed the miracle of a renewed marriage. Dear Mrs. Higgins,

Thank you very much for your communication of March 30; I had not expected any reply to my letter, knowing full well the volume the White House has to answer. However, I do appreciate the courtesy of a reply.

I should like to enlist your help today in getting to the President a book I am sending him addressed to you. I promised this book to Mr. Reagan a year ago even before he had been chosen as the Republican candidate. Now I want to keep my promise and trust that he will have a little time for reading during his period of recuperation. I know that this book -- one of two copies left to me -- is something he would want to read because of his interest in recent history. It is an account, by a personal friend of mine, who was also one of the few surviving leaders of the opposition against Hitler. Unfortunately, the author died shortly before our election last November; otherwise I would have asked him to autograph it. As it is, I autographed it to Mr. Reagan because I transated and edited it in close cooperation with the author.


Because the book is out of print, and because I feel it is something Mr. Reagan would really want to read, I hope you will see that he does get it when it arrives.

Dear Mr. President,

The book I am sending you may look a little shopworn, but that is only because it is my last copy save one of an out-of-print volume which I translated fifteen years ago for the author, who was a good friend of mine.

The book was not a success in the U.S., which was perhaps not surprising because it is the account of the fight against Hitler by one of the strongly conservative and deeply religious opponents of Hitler and his regime. To the American liberal opinionmakers, such an account was naturally anathema; it was not reviewed by the major newspapers.

It is precisely for that reason, however, that I believe you should read it; it may add invaluable dimensions to your concept of the totalitarian scourge, which has so many similarities in both its "brown" and its "red" forms. I know, because as an American child in Europe, I witnessed them both. I thought that you might perhaps have a little more time than usual during your period of recuperation from your injury, and this book may just be something you might like to read.

Unfortunately, Fabian von Schlabrendorff died just two months before your election from a heart attack, and so was not able to rejoice in your victory. That he would have rejoiced I know, for the drift in the U.S. had long been worrying him; he had a great affection for this country!

May I take this opportunity to tell you how deeply grateful we all are that the hand of God was with you on that fateful March 30, and with the others, too! I take it as an omen that you have been chosen to help this country back on the right track!

May you continue to make a good and complete recovery; our prayers are with you.
